AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 848 TO ARTICLE 1 OF
CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 1 OF THE GUAM CODE
ANNOTATE TO NAME THE TUMON/TAMUNING
POLICE STATION THE "SGT. FRANKIE E. SMITH
POLICE STATION."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative findings. The legislature would like to honor the service of Sgt. Frankie E. Smith, a police officer assigned to the Tumon/Tamuning Station who died in the line of duty on December 30, 2007 while answering a call to a disturbance in Tumon. This officer embodied the ideal of the good policeman: he

1 was full of character and compassion, and was well loved by his
2 coworkers. Sgt. Smith is a reminder that a policeman is always in
3 danger, even in the most ordinary of circumstances, and his loss to
4 the island a few days after Christmas is more than a loss to his
5 family and friends, but a loss to the entire Guam community of a
6 educated, capable, and compassionate guardian of our community.
7 It is fitting that the Tumon/Tamuning Police Station where he
8 worked should be named after him.

9 **Section 2.** A new § 848 is added to Article 1 of Chapter 8
10 of Title 1 of the Guam Code Annotated to read:
11 “§ 848. Sgt. Frankie E. Smith Police Station. The
12 Tumon/Tamuning Police Station located on #1041 Pale San
13 Vitores Road, Tumon Guam is named the “Sgt. Frankie E. Smith
14 Police Station” in honor of Sgt. Frankie E. Smith who gave his life
15 in the performance of his duty in Tumon on December 30, 2007.
