BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA TRENTAI SAIS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, Guam annually had a total of eleven (11) air service carriers, providing eleven thousand three hundred five (11,305) flights and two million two hundred fifty thousand three hundred seventy-eight (2,250,378) airline seats; and

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2020, Governor Lourdes Leon Guerrero signed Executive Order No. 2020-04, relative to responding to confirmed cases of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19), which established restrictions on entry into Guam in response to the pandemic, resulting in the drastic reduction in the number of flights and seats provided by air service carriers; and

WHEREAS, from May 1, 2020 to June 1, 2021, United Airlines, despite significant reductions in commercial flights, continued to provide lifeline and cargo transport services, bringing our people home and connecting us during critical times, carrying thirty thousand one hundred forty-five (30,145) passengers during this time period; and

WHEREAS, lifeline flights are services that remain in place to provide connections during times of emergency, such as providing medical evacuations and transporting life-saving supplies and equipment; and

WHEREAS, despite the COVID-19 pandemic disrupting life on Guam, United Airlines, a proud hometown airline for Guam, offered lifeline flights, using their passenger aircraft to bring in critical medical supplies, conduct medical evaluations, and fly in fresh goods and essentials. In addition, United's Guam-Honolulu service also provides important courier services for the medical industry through the delivery of essential medicines, medical supplies, and equipment while also supporting the U.S. Postal Service with daily mail service; and

WHEREAS, United Airlines has been serving the people of Guam for over fifty (50) years, with over eight hundred fifty (850) employees, nearly half of whom have nearly a quarter-century or more of service to the airline; and

WHEREAS, United Airlines has continued to be one of our island's most reliable carriers, working diligently throughout the pandemic to ensure that our people have a means of returning home, and that our island's supplies are continually being replenished; now therefore, be it

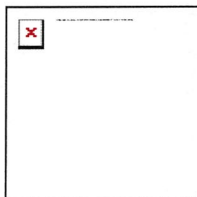




