**Relative to expressing the support of *I Mina'trentai Sais na Liheslaturan Guåhan* and advocating for the passage of H.R. 3730, which seeks to amend Title 38 of the United States Code to establish in the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs an Advisory Committee on United States Outlying Areas and Freely Associated States, and for other purposes.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI SAIS NA LIHESLATURAN***  
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs offers business, death,  
4 education, employment, financial, health, housing, legal advocacy and assistance,

1 memorial, recreation, state government services, tax, and territorial government  
2 services benefits to all United States military veterans; and

3 **WHEREAS**, according to the 2010 Island Area Census conducted by the U.S.  
4 Census Bureau, Guam has the highest percentage of veterans at 7.9 percent among the  
5 U.S. territories, and should have access to the benefits offered by the U.S. Department  
6 of Veterans Affairs; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Guam veterans in the past and in the present have vocalized their  
8 concern over the inadequate care they have received from the U.S. Department of  
9 Veterans Affairs, stating that they have experienced medical claims never being  
10 processed, the island having no specialized treatment facilities, and under-staffing at  
11 the VA Guam Community Based Outpatient Clinic, the island's only veteran outpatient  
12 health care site; and

13 **WHEREAS**, to resolve the benefit disparities, the Honorable Gregorio Kilili  
14 Camacho Sablan, CNMI Delegate, introduced H.R. 3730 in the U.S. House of  
15 Representatives with ten (10) co-sponsors, including the Honorable Michael F.Q. San  
16 Nicolas, Guam Delegate; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the purpose of H.R. 3730 is to establish in the U.S. Department of  
18 Veterans Affairs an Advisory Committee on United States Outlying Areas and Freely  
19 Associated States; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Advisory Committee will be comprised of fifteen (15) voting  
21 members appointed to represent covered veterans in eight (8) remote areas of the world,  
22 one of them being Guam; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the duties of Guam's Advisory Committee member representative  
24 will include:

1           “(1) To advise the Secretary on matters relating to covered veterans, including  
2 how the Secretary can improve the programs and services of the Department to better  
3 serve such veterans.

4           (2) To identify for the Secretary evolving issues of relevance to covered  
5 veterans.

6           (3) To propose clarifications, recommendations, and solutions to address  
7 issues raised by covered veterans.

8           (4) To provide a forum for covered veterans, veterans service organizations  
9 serving covered veterans, and the Department to discuss issues and proposals for  
10 changes to regulations, policies, and procedures of the Department.

11          (5) To identify priorities for and provide advice to the Secretary on appropriate  
12 strategies for consultation with veterans service organizations serving covered veterans.

13          (6) To encourage the Secretary to work with other departments and agencies  
14 of the Federal Government and Congress to ensure covered veterans are provided the  
15 full benefits of their status as covered veterans.

16          (7) To highlight contributions of covered veterans in the Armed Forces.

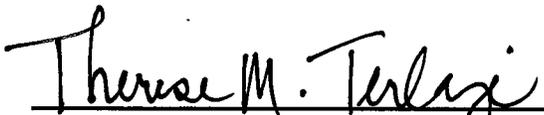
17          (8) To conduct other duties as determined appropriate by the Secretary.”; now  
18 therefore, be it

19           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Sais Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on  
20 behalf of the people of Guam, express its support and advocate for the passage of H.R.  
21 3730, which seeks to amend Title 38 of the United States Code to establish in the U.S.  
22 Department of Veterans Affairs an Advisory Committee on United States Outlying  
23 Areas and Freely Associated States, and for other purposes; and be it further

24           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the  
25 adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Honorable  
26 Nancy Pelosi, Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives; to the Honorable Mark

4 Nicolas, Delegate from Guam; to the Honorable Julia Brownley, U.S. Representative  
5 from California; to the Honorable Aumua Amata Coleman Radewagen, Delegate from  
6 American Samoa; to the Honorable Stacey E. Plaskett, Delegate from the U.S. Virgin  
7 Islands; to the Honorable Jenniffer González-Colón, Resident Commissioner of Puerto  
8 Rico; to the Honorable Kaiali'i Kahele, U.S. Representative from Hawai'i; to the  
9 Honorable Raúl M. Grijalva, U.S. Representative from Arizona; to the Honorable Ed
