**WHEREAS**, the week of October 10 to October 16, 2021 was designated as "National School Lunch Week" (NSLW) by President Joe Biden; and the first observance of NSLW was on October 9, 1962 when it was instituted by President John F. Kennedy upon the enactment of U.S. Public Law 87-780, as amended; and the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) was created to promote the importance of a healthy school lunch in a child's life and the impact it has inside and outside of the classroom, with the NSLP serving healthy meals to approximately thirty million (30,000,000) students every school day; and

**WHEREAS**, when the Guam Department of Education schools were initially shut down because of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Food and Nutrition Services Management Division, the Child Nutrition Program, the Cafeteria Staff, and the Food Service Management Company employees were our frontline heroes as they reported to work and prepared nutritious meals for Guam's school students during the summer of 2020; and


**WHEREAS**, the team of employees rapidly organized and assembled approximately seven million (7,000,000) nutritionally balanced food packages through the Grab-N-Go school meal service for the students, in addition to being assigned to distribute nonperishable items, milk, and fresh produce at numerous satellite sites and warehouses to accommodate students and help to alleviate health and economic challenges; and the staff practiced and followed traditional sanitary guidelines in addition to learning and following the newly-added standard of COVID-19 protocols and resolutions established by the Guam Homeland Security/Office of Civil Defense; and they fully cooperated in the island-wide food commodities distribution program and the Emergency Food Assistance Program under the U.S. Department of Agriculture Food Nutrition Services, in partnership with Guam's village Mayors and community organizations; and the teams gave their support in providing free food commodities to non-profit organizations, such as Catholic Social Service, Sanctuary, Incorporated of Guam, and the Guam Department of Youth Affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the nutrition staff overcame obstacles such as fear and anxiety, as well as other challenges during the COVID-19 pandemic, and they learned how to acclimate themselves to the expectations beyond their normal operations to meet the demands of the community; and although they faced significant setbacks they persevered and they carried out their responsibilities and shifted their energy and efforts to ensure that Guam's students and the community were fed, as they were a key part of Guam's community response to the pandemic; now therefore, be it






