WHEREAS, these Lions Clubs International District 204 officers for 2020/2021 are largely responsible for the many activities and projects undertaken districtwide which include the inauguration of District Governor Lion Sumie Kuba, PMJF, which was virtually held by International President Dr. Jung-Yul Choi; several virtual zoom meeting etiquette training conducted by Lion Roy Adonay, District Alert Committee Chair; the adoption of the Airport Road as Island wide Beautification; the installation of District Officers and Committee Chairperson; Club Officers Training virtually conducted by GAT Team; New Membership Orientation virtually conducted by GAT Team; Guiding Lions Training virtually conducted by GAT Team; the chartering of Saipan Fitbeat Lions Club; New Membership Orientation/Club Officers Training conducted by GAT Team; observance of International LEO Day where Leo of Guam and Saipan presented club activities to each other virtually for the first time, led by LP Patti Quichocho, District Leo Chair; Emergent Leadership Lions Institutes held virtually and conducted by GAT Team; the first OSEAL New Year Get Together in January 2021; Presentation of the GAT success story “D204 Annual Health Fairs” held virtually by Lion Jason Soliva, Co-Chair of District Public Relations and Lions Information Committee; the District 204 Convention and electronic voting held virtually for the first time; collaboration with the Lions of Japan to hold the Personal Protective Equipment Donation Ceremony at Adelup and virtually with eighty Lions from Japan, including PIP Dr. Jitsuhiro Yamada, Chairman Yasunobu Shikina, all 35 District Governors, Directors of Japan and supportive Lions Clubs Officers where the Lions of Japan donated \$77,500.00 worth of PPEs to Covid-19 Pandemic Frontliners of on Guam which included 10,800 bottles of hand sanitizer, 5,000 Medical Gown Sets to DPHSS, GMH, GFD and GRMC, 35,000 Nitrile gloves, and 1,000 face shields; and

WHEREAS, despite the many challenges posed by the Covid-19 pandemic, the Lions of District 204 persevered and continued their leadership training and community

1 improvement projects including the Worldwide New Member Induction virtually held
2 by GAT Team; the New Member Orientation held virtually by GAT Team; the OSEAL
3 LEO FORUM Get Together; the Airport Road Cleanup; the Second OSEAL New Year
4 Get Together in July 2021; Two Lions Quest: Social and Emotional Learning
5 Customized Webinars; Lions Quest: Professional Development; Club Officers Training
6 and Induction; the Lions Roaring Fun Day Camp Project focusing Social and Emotional
7 Learning; the adoption of San Vitores Road from Nikko Hotel to GPD Precinct in
8 Tumon; the adoption of Ipao Beach as an island beautification project; participation in
9 the first virtual International Parade of Nations at the Lions Clubs International
10 Convention, published the first History Book of District 204: "The Birth of Lionism in
11 Micronesia"; and were featured in three consecutive publications of Lions Magazine
12 Japan. Now, therefore, be it
