- WHEREAS, the Guam Customs and Quarantine Agency is Guam's first line of defense in protecting our borders and securing our ports of entry to protect the people of Guam; and
- WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General represents the Government of Guam, prosecutes on behalf of the people of Guam, and upholds the rule of law; and
- WHEREAS, the Guam International Airport Authority Police seeks to ensure the safety and security of the traveling public, and to support and assist in the development of air service for the island; and
- WHEREAS, the Port Authority of Guam Police are functionally responsible for the protection of life and property through the Authority's security rules and regulations, Guam's criminal and motor codes, the Maritime Security Act, and applicable federal and local security programs, laws, rules, and regulations; and
- WHEREAS, Guam Homeland Security coordinates and facilitates all Government of Guam, Military, and Federal Liaison Response Agencies and their resources in mitigating, preparing, responding, and recovering from all types of emergencies in order to protect lives, the environment, and the property of the island of Guam; and
- WHEREAS, the Guam Department of Agriculture Conservation Officers seek to protect and recover Guam's native fish and wildlife resources, and they continue to monitor, manage, and recover Guam's natural resources; and
- WHEREAS, the Guam Department of Corrections, in collaboration with the Guam Parole Board, protects the public from the destructive action of law offenders through control and rehabilitation; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Youth Affairs improves the quality of life on Guam for all people through the development and implementation of programs and services that promote youth development, decreases juvenile delinquency and status offenses, and strengthens the family unit and communities of juvenile offenders; and
- WHEREAS, the Judiciary of Guam, in conjunction with the Probation Division and the Marshal Division, administers justice by interpreting and upholding the laws, resolving disputes in a timely manner, and providing accessible, efficient, and effective court services; and
- WHEREAS, the Guam Department of Public Works is responsible for performing a wide variety of public service activities and ensuring compliance with statutes by conducting quality control for construction, infrastructure, maintenance, and road repair projects, and providing busing transportation for all school students; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Territorial Park Patrol Officers, and the State Historic Preservation Officer promote health and wellness through community recreation programs, recreational facilities, and maintenance of public parks and restrooms; and they work to protect and preserve Guam's historic and cultural resources; and
- WHEREAS, Guam's law enforcement officers work and collaborate with federal, local, and regional counterparts to assist and aid the community with programs and campaigns to include, but not be limited to: Neighborhood Watch Groups, Volunteers in Police Service Programs (VIPS), Stop the Evil, Summer Youth Employment Internship Programs, Guam Adult Re-entry Court Programs, Prescription Take-Back Day, Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over, Click-It or Ticket, TOKA Hotline & TOKA App, Victim Information Notification Everyday (VINE), and the Citizens Corps Program, all for the betterment of our island community; and


