## BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI SAIS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, the month of March is recognized as "Developmental Disabilities

Awareness Month" and is dedicated to increasing awareness by educating the

community on the challenges, needs and potential of persons with developmental

6 disabilities; and

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WHEREAS, the Developmental Disabilities Assistance and Bill of Rights Act (DD Act) defines a developmental disability as a severe, chronic disability of an individual that is attributable to a mental or physical impairment, or a combination of both, that manifests itself before the individual reaches the age of twenty-two (22) and is likely to continue indefinitely. Disabilities, however, are a natural part of the human

experience and do not diminish the right of these individuals to live independently, or to fully participate in and contribute to society; and

WHEREAS, in 2000, President Bill Clinton reauthorized and signed the DD Act into law, which maintains State Councils and Developmental Disabilities in each state and territory to conduct outreach, to provide training and technical assistance, to shape policies, and to promote inclusion, to include the establishment of the Guam Developmental Disabilities Council (GDDC). This Act also continues Protection and Advocacy (P&A) systems and University Centers for Excellence in Developmental Disabilities Education, Research and Service (UCEDDS) to operate alongside these councils. The P&A and UCEDDS on Guam, respectively, are the Guam Legal Services Corporation – Disability Law Center (GLSC-DLC) and the University of Guam Center for Excellence in Developmental Disabilities Education, Research, and Service (CEDDERS); and

WHEREAS, the GDDC, together with the GLSC-DLC and CEDDERS, is instrumental in the advocacy and promotion of programs that allow individuals with developmental disabilities to achieve optimum independence and improve their quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month is a time to dispel misconceptions about people living with developmental disabilities and to bring communities together, with the ultimate goal of creating an environment that is more inclusive and accepting of our developmental disability population. It is also a time to reflect on the progress made towards improving the quality of life for these individuals and their families; and

WHEREAS, this year's Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month theme has been inspired by our community's ability to adapt and persevere through the COVID-19 pandemic, with the theme as "The Virtual Reality: Embracing New Ways

to Stay Safe, Informed and Connected," recognizing the impact the COVID-19 1 pandemic has had on society which has affected the traditional methods with which 2 people have interacted socially. While many around the world continue to observe 3 protocols and recommendations from medical professionals to help control the spread 4 of the virus, online and other virtual communication platforms have made it safer, easier 5 and more convenient for people to stay better informed and connected with one another, 6 creating an environment that is more inclusive; now therefore be it 7 RESOLVED, that I Mina'trentai Sais Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on 8
