7	hired in September 1990 before the hotel officially opened in February 1992; and
8	WHEREAS, Mr. Blas was the first local CHamoru to achieve the level of
9	Executive Hotelier at the Hotel Nikko Guam and coined the hotel's phrase "The Resort
10	in Paradise" to share his passion about Guam and the CHamoru culture; and
11	WHEREAS, Mr. Blas has ensured that the CHamoru culture is ubiquitous within

- 1 the Hotel Nikko Guam's corporate culture and included in their uniform design, logo,
- 2 food, and music; and

- 4 companies to take the "Håfa Adai Pledge" and recite their pledge in CHamoru;
