3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero was born and raised on Guam and is originally from
4 the village of Dededo; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero is from the “Familian Deso” clan and has been a
6 current resident of Yigo for over 20 years with his beautiful family; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Francisco “Frank” Taitano Guerrero has over 50 years of
8 combined dedication to Guam’s tourism visitor industry and an enlisted Chamorro
9 leader and advisor to various levels of command as a retired U.S. Army Command
10 Sergeant Major; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero served over 26 years with Lam Lam Tours and
2 Transportation as the Assistant General Manager, Director of Training and
3 Development, who is responsible for numerous training activities such as Defensive
4 Driving, Effective Customer Service, Sexual Harassment, Fire Extinguisher Safety,
5 and Fleet Maintenance Operations, managing Lam Lam Tours 55 fleet of busses,
6 vans, and the iconic “Red Trolley Busses”; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero has organized and collaborated with the Japan
8 Travel Bureau and sister company of Lam Lam Tours, Pacific Micronesia Tour, along
9 with other Japan travel agents on Guam with events and educations programs such as
10 the Japanese Wedding Services, Guam Village Fiesta Tours, Two Lovers Point New
11 Year Fireworks, the Annual Japanese Festival tour, and various tourism clean-ups;

13 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero actively coordinated several educational programs
14 working hand-in hand with students from Simon Sanchez High School, Guam
15 Community College and University of Guam; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero was a 2005 Rotary Club of Guam (RCOG) Past
17 President and since 1995 has been an active member with the Guam Chamber of
18 Commerce, Guam Hotel & Restaurant Association and the GVB Japan Marketing
19 Committee; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero has been in involved in numerous RCOG signature
21 projects such as the Alee children’s Shelter, tree planting program, Salvation Army

1 Thanksgiving donations, dictionary distribution to elementary students as well as used
2 books donations in the Guam/Kuriuzawa Sister Club Student Exchange Programs; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero is also a reputable Retired U.S Army Special Forces
4 Green Beret, Command Sergeant Major, a Leader to approximately 3,000 soldiers and
5 their families of 30 years; and

6 **WHEREAS**, after twenty-six (26) years Mr. Guerrero will retire from the
7 Tourisms industry; now therefore be it
