












2 of Guam’s youth; and

3 **WHEREAS**, school counselors are unsung heroes in our community who go
4 above and beyond the call of duty to help students explore their strengths, interests, and
5 talents; and

6 **WHEREAS**, school counselors are community partners who collaborate with
7 various stakeholders, organizations, and social services agencies to help families fully
8 support the growth of students academically, socially, mentally, and in their personal
9 lives, as school counselors are open-minded individuals who believe there are always
10 ways to solve problems and overcome challenges; and

11 **WHEREAS**, our island’s school counselors are vital to the continued growth of
12 public and private schools for future generations to come; and throughout any changes
13 in our community, school counselors are professionals who stay current with diverse
14 and comprehensive ways to address the needs of our island students; and

15 **WHEREAS**, school counseling programs are designed to foster a foundation for
16 lifelong learning by removing barriers of students’ academic success; early
17 identification and intervention is essential in removing barriers to learning and
18 promoting academic growth; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Guam’s school counselors provide direct and indirect
20 studentservices and curricular activities to increase the knowledge, skills, and attitudes
21 of their students to achieve their potential inside and outside the school setting; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Guam Association of School Counselors mission is to represent
23 and support the work of school counselors by promoting professionalism and ethical
24 practices, as Guam school counselors are committed to advancing the professional
25 development of school counseling through comprehensive and data driven programs;
