1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SAIS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***
3 **WHEREAS,** The Filipino-American Presidents Club of Guam was chartered in
4 1984 with the purpose of fostering unity and closer relationships among members, to
5 work toward creating a more vibrant community, to provide humanitarian support to
6 the people of Guam and abroad in time of need, and to engage in activities and
7 functions consistent with the association goals; and

1 **WHEREAS** since its inception, the Filipino-American Presidents Club of
2 Guam has supported numerous causes and projects, among which are: the American
3 Cancer Society, the American Red Cross, Lytico & Bodig Association, the Carmelite
4 Sisters, the Guam Museum Foundation, St. Dominic Senior Care Home, the
5 Archbishop Felixberto Flores memorial statue, the FCG Leyte Mudslide Fund, the
6 Blindness Foundation in the Philippines, the Hurricane Katrina Fund, and to the
7 victims of several major typhoons in the Philippines; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the Filipino-American Presidents Club of Guam also supported
9 the activities of other community groups such as the Filipino Ladies Association of
10 Guam and the Filipino Community of Guam; and

11 **WHEREAS**, for the years 2020 and 2021, the chairwoman of the Filipino-
12 American Presidents Club of Guam was Loisa M. Cabuhat; and

13 **WHEREAS**, under the leadership of Loisa M. Cabut as its Chairwoman, the
14 Filipino-American Presidents Club of Guam continued its scholarship grants to
15 University of Guam students, its annual humanitarian project during the holiday season
16 of feeding Guam's homeless through *Kamalen Karidat*, and provided financial support

1 to Santa Barbara Catholic Church in Dededo and to *Nino Perdido Y Sagrada Familia*
2 Catholic Church in Asan in support of Christmas *Misa de Gallo*; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in addition to continuing the annual projects undertaken by the
4 Filipino-American Presidents Club of Guam, past chairwoman Loisa M. Cabuhat over
5 saw the presentation of the \$1,500.00 donation to Filipino Community of Guam's
6 Typhoon Fund Drive for the victims of Typhoons Rolly and Ulysses in the Philippines
7 in Nov. 2020; the donation of a large screen television set to House of Mercy, a shelter
8 for foster children on May 19, 2021; the donation of assorted toiletries, personal hygiene
9 items, alcohol, and face masks to the elderly sisters of Mercy Care Center on Dec. 19,
10 2021; and the donation of two wheelchairs to Department of Public Health & Social
11 Services for the Covid -19 operations on Dec. 29, 2021; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Loisa M. Cabuhat, ensuring that it was not all work and no play
13 during the course of her tenure, saw to it that the members of the Club gathered for
14 fellowship and celebration on President's Day, Father's Day, Mother's Day and
15 Thanksgiving/Christmas; and

16 **WHEREAS**, many, both on Guam and abroad, have benefitted greatly from the
17 efforts of the membership of the Filipino-American Presidents Club of Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Loisa M. Cabuhat, during her term as Chairwoman of the Filipino-
2 American Presidents Club of Guam, gave freely of her time and leadership skills for the
3 benefit of other people and causes rather than for financial benefit. Now therefore, be
4 it

5 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Sais Na*
6 *Lihsaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihsaturan Guåhan* and the people
7 of Guam, recognizes Loisa M. Cabuhat for her exemplary service to the people of Guam
8 as Chairwoman of the Filipino-American Presidents Club of Guam for 2020-2021; and
9 thanks her for her for her many contributions toward the betterment of our community;
