Relative to recognizing Elmer Servidad Sardoma for his 36 years of service to the people of Guam with the Guam Police Department and congratulating him on the occasion of his retirement.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**

2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SAIS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Elmer Servidad Sardoma was born on February 29, 1956 to the
4 late Burt and Juanita Sardoma; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Elmer Servidad Sardoma is married to Elena B. Sardoma and
6 their children are James, Michael, and Jennifer; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Elmer Servidad Sardoma is a 1975 graduate of George
8 Washington High School in Mangilao, Guam, attended Kemper Military School
9 Junior College in Boonville Missouri where he graduated with an Associate of Arts

1 degree, studied Criminal Justice and psychology at the University of Guam, and
2 graduated with Guam's 24th Police Officer Training Cycle; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Elmer Servidad Sardoma joined the Guam Police Department in
4 1982 as an undercover officer with the Narcotics and Vice Section and during his
5 assignment with the section it set the record for the most one-day arrests for illegal
6 gambling; and

7 **WHEREAS**, while assigned to the Narcotics and Vice Section, Elmer Servidad
8 Sardoma gathered information and submitted an intelligence report which led to the
9 arrest of the perpetrators of several homicides; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in 1985, Elmer Servidad Sardoma was temporarily assigned to the
11 Office of the Attorney General's White Collar Task Force to investigate the
12 circumstances surrounding alleged criminal activity involving government officials and
13 private vendors. This resulted in convictions and the recovery of over Two Million
14 Dollars from those convicted; and

15 **WHEREAS**, in 1987, Elmer Servidad Sardoma ended his assignment with the
16 Office of the Attorney General and assumed duties with the Patrol Section, then on to
17 the Department's Intelligence Section during which time he was able to solve a

1 homicide case which led him to locate and recover the victim's remains and identify the
2 perpetrator; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Elmer Servidad Sardoma was assigned to the Narcotics Section and
4 the Detective Section where he worked on major cases involving homicide, major theft,
5 and drug dealing where aided in convictions and asset forfeiture; and

6 **WHEREAS**, during the course of his career as a police officer, Elmer Servidad
7 Sardoma held such leadership positions as Officer in Charge of Internal Affairs, Officer
8 in Charge of Tactical Operations Command, Officer in Charge of the Property Section,
9 Officer in Charge of the Special Operations Division, which included SWAT, the Police
10 Reserve Program, the Harbor Section, Processing Section, and Executive Security; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Elmer Servidad Sardoma continued his education and training
12 while with the Guam Police Department having graduated from the U.S. ARMY
13 Criminal Investigation Division apprenticeship program at Fort McClellan, Alabama
14 and the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Advanced Arson Investigation Course; and

15 **WHEREAS**, in September of 2019, Elmer Servidad Sardoma, having achieved
16 the rank of Sergeant and serving for 36 years as one of Guam's Finest, retired from the
17 Government of Guam. Now therefore, be it

1 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Sais Na*
2 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
3 of Guam, recognizes Elmer Servidad Sardoma for his 36 years of service to the people
4 of Guam with the Guam Police Department and congratulating him on the occasion of
5 his retirement; and be it further

6 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
7 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to the adoption hereof, and that copies of the
8 same be thereafter transmitted to Elmer Servidad Sardoma; and to the Honorable
9 Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero, *I Maga'hågan Guåhan*.
