BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI SAIS NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:

WHEREAS, the "2021 Click It or Ticket" National Enforcement Mobilization Campaign is observed from May 17 through June 6, 2021, with an emphasis on High-Visibility Enforcement (HVE), a universal traffic safety approach designed to create deterrence and change unlawful traffic safety behaviors; and

WHEREAS, "Click It or Ticket" is an annual national campaign that was first implemented in 1993, which promotes the importance of using your seatbelts while riding in vehicles; and the campaign focuses on safety education, strong laws, and law enforcement support to save lives. It is also an enforcement campaign where law enforcement agencies locally and nationwide are stepping up their enforcement efforts for motorists who are not buckled up; and

WHEREAS, seatbelts are highly effective in preventing deaths and serious injuries to occupants of motor vehicles; and seatbelts are available in most passenger vehicles, are easy to use, and have been proven to be one of the best ways to save lives; and

WHEREAS, Guam's newest seatbelt law, Public Law 30-33, took effect on January 1, 2010, which requires the use of a seatbelt assembly and child restraint system, and clarifies standards for riding in the bed of a pickup truck. The first offense for not wearing a seatbelt is a One Hundred Dollar (\$100) fine, and if someone is pulled over and ticketed again for not wearing a seatbelt, the penalty doubles; and

WHEREAS, Guam's seatbelt usage rate increased from 92.24% in 2018 to 96.95% in 2019, ranking second (2nd) in the nation for seatbelt usage. Based on preliminary findings, from 2015 to 2019, there were only seven (7) unrestrained passenger vehicle occupant fatalities as of December 12, 2020. Guam recorded three hundred forty-four (344) seatbelt citations in 2019 and one hundred fifty-one (151) in 2020; and also recorded one hundred thirty (130) child restraint citations in 2019 and sixty-three (63) in 2020; and

WHEREAS, Guam is amongst thirty-five (35) states and U.S. territories that have primary seatbelt laws for front seat occupants; and primary seatbelt laws allow law enforcement officers to issue citations to a driver or passenger for not wearing a seatbelt; and

WHEREAS, Guam participates annually in the "Click It or Ticket" campaign with educational outreach events and law enforcement activities that target high-risk crash areas. These elements comprise awareness efforts that have guided our island's high seatbelt usage rate and increased overall seatbelt safety; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Minatrentai Sais Na Liheslaturan Guahan does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, observe the "2021 Click It or Ticket" National Enforcement Mobilization Campaign from May 17 through June 6, 2021, and recognize its members for their community initiatives to ensure highway and occupant safety; and further commend the Guam Department of Public Works – Office of Highway Safety, together with its Partners for Highway Safety, the Guam Police Department - Highway Patrol Division; the Guam International Airport Authority - Airport Police Division; the Port Authority of Guam - Port Police Division; the Office of the Attorney General - DUI Prosecution; the Judiciary of Guam - DWI Court and DWI Enhancement Program; and the Guam Fire Department for promoting and encouraging safe driving by utilizing seatbelts and child restraint systems, and the awareness of seatbelt safety; and be it further
