WHEREAS, the late U.S. Navy Steward's Mate 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Jesus Francisco Garcia was born in Hagåtña; and he is the son of †Ana Cabrera Francisco and †Antonio San Nicolas Garcia, and is one (1) of ten (10) siblings; and

WHEREAS, the late U.S. Navy Steward's Mate 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Jesus Francisco Garcia was assigned to serve on the battleship USS Oklahoma, which was moored at Ford Island in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, and he lost his life on December 7, 1941, when the USS Oklahoma capsized during the attack on Pearl Harbor by Japan in World War II; and

WHEREAS, the remains of the late U.S. Navy Steward's Mate 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Jesus Francisco Garcia were recovered and interred in Hawaii as an "unknown" at the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific in Hawaii; and

WHEREAS, in 2015, the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency exhumed the "unknowns" of the USS Oklahoma from the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific during their project to recover and identify the remains of the remaining three hundred eighty-eight (388) Sailors and Marines; and

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2018, the late U.S. Navy Steward's Mate 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Jesus Francisco Garcia was accounted for after almost eighty (80) years had passed; and the family of the late U.S. Navy Steward's Mate 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Jesus Francisco Garcia were notified on August 27, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the people of Guam give their utmost and endless gratitude and respect to the late U.S. Navy Steward's Mate 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Jesus Francisco Garcia for his dedicated service and sacrifice in defense of our island and nation; and
