Confusion spreads as Italy attempts to lock down 16M

ROME (The Washington Post) -Italy on Sunday launched a complicated and urgent plan to restrict the movement of roughly 16 million people, a measure that unleasned confusion about how it could be enforced and whether it would be enough to slow the spread of the coronavirus.

The plan to lock down large swaths of the north was the first major attempt by a democracy during the coronavirus crisis to radically halt the routines of daily life - an effort that will have significant effects on civil liberties. But in the hours before and after the measure became law, people continued to streamout of the northern hubs of Milan and Venice on trains and planes for southern Italy or elsewhere in Europe.

SEOUL (Bloomberg News) - North Korea fired three unidentified projectiles off its eastern coast Monday South Korea's defense min.stry said in a text message, in its second such launch in a week that raises security concerns as world leaders are battling the coronavirus outbreak.

"We're all in a state of confusion," said Ez'o Mauro, former editor in chief of the Rome newspaper La Repubblica "The (Italian) government is finding itself in a difficult spot because it is experimenting, fighting against an enemy whose origin, nature, effects and consequences are unknown."

Data released by Italy on Sunday night underscored the urgency. Active cases jumped more than 1,300 in a single day to 6,387, and deaths jumped by 133 to 366.

Saudiroyal family have been detained in the Saudi capital of Riyadh, a move that could be designed to further strengthen the position of the kingdom's de facto ruler, according to two people close to Saudi leadership.

Prince Ahmed bin Abdulaziz, an uncle of Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman and one of his cousins, Mohammed bin Nayef, were taken into custody Friday morning, the people said, speaking on the condition of anonymity to discuss highly sensitive internal Saudi matters.

China: No locally transmitted coronavirus cases outside Hubei

BEIJING (Reuters) - Mainfand China, outside Hubei province, the epicenter of the coronavirus outbreak, reported no new locally transmitted cases on Sunday for the second straight day, as authorities remained on alert for infections arriving from abroad.

China had 40 new confirmed cases of coronavirus infections on Sunday, the National Health Commission said Monday, down from 44 cases a day earlier, and the lowest number since the nealth authority started publishing nationwide data on Jan. 20.


Of the new cases on Sunday, 36 were new infections in Wuhan, the provincial capital of Hubei, while the remaining four in Gansu province were imported from Iran.

The total number of imported cases hit 67, including the four Gansu cases.

The new cases on Sunday bring the total accumulated number of confirmed cases in mainland China to 80,735

While the domestic spread of the virus has significantly slowed in recent days, authorities continue to be mindful of risks stemming from people - foreigners and Chinese nationals - traveling back to China from affected regions

Shanghai stepped up a rport screening over the weekend as imported coronavirus infections from countries such as Italy and Iran emerged as the biggest source of imported cases in China
