Crisostomo stated that additional revenue is anticipated for the month of March, and that C. San Nicolas stated that what was presented was only a snapshot of what has been received to date. 3. S. Crisostomo expressed concerns that HPLO revenues being used to help fund DPHSS mandates, but unfunded, requirements. D. Borja, HPLO, stated that she would obtain specifics examples of and provide information to the GBAHE regarding the unfunded DPHSS mandates. The Chair stated when the GBAHE Rules and Regulations are submitted and ratified by the 36th Guam Legislature, this would indicate justification for HPLO's budget to meet some of its mandates. But HPLO's budget serves all Licensure Boards, not the Allied Health Board alone. She reminded the Board that this Board's collection of fees only made up of 13% of HPLO's total budget. San Nicolas recommended that the GBAHE approach the issue with an aim to be helpful to the public and to avoid any liability. She said that a Board member(s), when confronting a business establishment or individual suspected of providing services without a proper valid licensure issued by this Board, that another individual should be present as a possible witness, instead of approaching or arbitrary confronting them alone. record(s) earns the title. Even if the best team is three different teams.

1st championship

But because of reduced school days and COVID-19 restrictions, things were different this year. ISA Director for Middle Schools Caroline Cardines-Finch said the reduced school days left middle school basketball with not enough time to play a double-round-robin, meaning every team gets to play every other team twice.

Rather than award a third of a trophy, Cardines-Finch and her crew decided to let the teams earn one whole trophy.

"I'm getting goosebumps thinking about it. Having playoff games definitely created a different kind of energy in middle school sports," said Cardines-Finch. "Being able to say your school is part of the final four teams brought a lot of pride to the players and coaches."

Proud coaches

Roadrunner coach Erwin Villa was happy to put his third of the championship trophy up for grabs.

"Oh man, I was so ex-

cited. With the playoffs, you're able to see who is really the top team because every year, whenever you have teams that are tied, you can't determine who's the champion. With these playoffs, you can. And the kids were really excited to have it."

Pirates coach Calvin Fejeran agreed. The Pirates advanced with a win over the Wildcats. The Roadrunners, seeded first based on total points scored, advanced with a win over the Astumbo Dragons. The Roadrunners beat the Pirates by a large margin during the regular season, but the Pirates were a different team Wednesday.

The Pirates led by as much as 11 points in the final minutes, but a 9-0 Roadrunners run over 43 seconds made it 38-36 with 40 seconds left in the game. It took four straight free throws by Phoenix Borja to put the game out of the Roadrunners' reach. The Pirates' Borja scored 19 and Darnell Camacho scored
