GHURA board approves Napoli and Esteves appointments

Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority has new but familiar names leading the agency.

After nearly five months of being at the helm in an acting capacity, Elizabeth Napoli was approved by GHURA's Board of Commissioners to serve as executive director, officially on July 8.

She succeeds the late Ray S. Topasna, who had served as executive director

since the beginning of the Leon Guerrero-Tenorio administration in 2019 until he died in February.

Meanwhile, former one-term Sen. Fernando Esteves was tapped by the Leon Guerrero-Tenorio administration to serve as GHURA's deputy director.

GHURA's board greenlighted Esteves' appointment on July 26, during its meeting.

All voted in favor of his appointment, with starting pay being \$92,496 a year, which is \$44.32 per hour.

"He's looking forward to working with the GHURA team and carrying on Mr. Topasna, our late director's, legacy and working with Ms. Liz and the staff," said Kim Bersamin, GHURA's personnel services administrator.

His appointment was based on two factors.

"One is of course the factor of years of executive level and management experience, as well as the No. 2 factor is HR experience on the financial side," Bersamin said.

Esteves was elected to the 34th Guam Legislature and decided not to seek reelection in 2018.

Up until his new post at GHURA, he served as incident commander for the Department of Public Health and Social Services.

Esteves also serves part-time with the Guam Army National Guard.



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FBI launches cybersecurity awareness campaign for Guam businesses **Ransomware: Ransom are increasingly a paint of surface the launchest of t

Because of a growing threat of cyberattacks and to educate private sector businesses and organizations on Guam, the FBI Honolulu Field Office -Guam Resident Agency has launched a cybersecurity awareness campaign to "encourage businesses to establish a proactive relationship with FBI Guam Resident Agency before a cyber incident occurs."

A news release from the FBI Hono-Iulu Field Office announced the launch of the cybersecurity awareness campaign on Aug. 11.

"FBI Honolulu is committed to investigating and combating any malicious cyber activity targeting the private sectors. In addition to agents, analysts, and computer scientists who track and counter emerging cyber threats, we work closely with our law enforcement and cybersecurity partners throughout the state," said FBI Special Agent in Charge Steven Merrill. "We encourage you to partner with us to serve as force multipliers to protect our country's cyber defenses and your assistance in working together to strengthen your organization's response plans against cyberattacks."

The FBI highlighted these cyber threats:

· Critical infrastructure attacks: The private sector controls most of the country's critical infrastructure, intellectual property, and personal data, making large businesses and small corporations targets of cyberattacks. While nation-state threats remain the most significant threat to critical infrastructure because of their persistence, sophistication, and potential for destructive intent, ransomware attacks by cybercriminals have already targeted U.S. critical infrastructure, including emergency services, hospitals, and the energy sector.

Ransomware: Ransomware is a type of malicious software that cybercriminals and nation-state actors often deploy after they have hacked into a victim's computer to encrypt their data. These bad actors then demand payment of a ransom to unlock the encrypted data. The FBI

has observed ransomware attacks become more targeted and has seen the ransoms increase significantly in recent years. When a ransomware incident occurs, swift communication with the FBI could positively impact data recovery efforts. Through victim engagement, the FBI develops a greater understanding of the different variants and ransomware groups to help prevent future attacks.

 Supply chain attacks: A business' cybersecurity is only as strong as that of its trusted vendors. The FBI warns companies to know that supply chains

are increasingly a point of vulnerability for computer intrusions.

According to the release, organizations who are the victims of a network intrusion may contact the FBI Hono-Iulu Field Office - Guam Resident Agency at 671-472-7465 or the FBI's 24/7 CyWatch at 855-292-3937 or cywatch@fbi.gov.

Speed matters when responding to an intrusion, as criminals can quickly destroy network operations. Rapid notification allows the FBI to quickly deploy our cyber experts to preserve evidence and work with a company's incident responders to help recover their networks," the news release

The FBI Honolulu Field Office -Guam Resident Agency advises that "the most vital step a company or organization can take to protect itself is to implement good cyberhygiene practices."


