Chairman Anthony P. Benavente, Commissioner John Smith, and Commissioner Robert C. Taitano.

Maria Masnayon, Personnel Management Analyst III, read the report into the record. Ms. Chargualaf received an envelope from Chris Duenas, HR Administrative Assistant, at her desk February 15, 2022. The envelope contained a campaign fund raising ticket for Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00). Co-workers, Jamie Pangelinan and Jesse Libby also received an envelope with tickets.

Staff concluded that all four (4) Employees violated 4 GCA, Chapter 5, Section 5103 (the political activity law) for using government facilities for the benefit of a political party. Staff concluded that all four employees had limited or no understanding of the Political Activity Law. The Commission voted 4 to 0 that all four violated the statute.

The Commission deliberated on what penalty to levy on the Employees. Commissioner Taitano voted to suspend Chris Duenas for five (5) days without pay. The remaining Commissioners voted to take no further action with no penalties for the other three (3) Employees; Jaime Pangelinan, Nicole Chargualaf, and Jesse Libby because the Employees did not know that they were violating the law. The vote being 3 to 1 (Commissioner Taitano dissenting) no four (4)
