**AN ACT TO AMEND § 403(1) OF CHAPTER 4, TITLE 1,  
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO  
CHANGING THE OFFICIAL NAME OF THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF “SANTA RITA” TO ITS NAME IN  
THE *CHAMORU* LANGUAGE, NAMELY “SANTA RITA-  
SUMAI.”**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1.** § 403(1) of Chapter 4, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby  
3 *amended* to read:

4           “(1) Sânta Rita-Sumai Village. Beginning at the western tip of the Glass  
5 Breakwater running southeasterly through Apra Harbor to the mouth of the  
6 Atantano River, thence southeasterly along the Atantano and Paulana Rivers to

1 the head of the Paulana River, thence northeasterly to the Mt. Tenjo Triangulation  
2 Station, thence southeasterly to the northeastern corner of the United States Naval  
3 Magazine boundary, thence southerly along its eastern boundary to its  
4 southeastern corner, thence westerly along the southern boundary of said Naval  
5 Magazine to corner FR5 of the Fena Valley watershed boundary, thence  
6 northwesterly through the said Naval Magazine to the southernmost corner of Lot  
7 No. 250, then northwesterly along the western boundary of said Lot through Lot  
8 No. 266 and the western boundary of Lot No. 213, thence easterly along the  
9 northern boundaries of Lots No. 213 and 216 to the northeastern corner of Lot  
10 No. 216, thence northerly along the western boundary of Lot No. 240 to its  
11 northwestern corner, thence northwesterly along the Namu River to its mouth,  
12 thence northwesterly along the coastline to Orote Point, thence northeasterly to  
13 the point of beginning.”

14 **Section 2.** All references to “*Santa Rita*” in the Guam Code Annotated and the  
15 laws, rules, and regulations of Guam shall be understood to refer to “*Santa Rita-Sumai*.”
