

**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 849.15 TO ARTICLE 1 OF
CHAPTER 8, TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,
RELATIVE TO DESIGNATING ROUTE 3 AS “BG BEN
BLAZ MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.”**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that Marine Corps Base Camp Blaz, which was activated on October 1, 2020, was
4 named in honor of Brigadier General (BG) Vicente “Ben” Blaz, United States
5 Marine Corps, who is the first *CHamoru* to achieve flag rank in the armed forces of
6 the United States. General Blaz retired in 1980 and returned home to Guam; and he
7 was subsequently elected to serve as Guam’s Delegate to Congress in 1984. He was
8 a strong advocate for the political advancement of Guam and the Mariana Islands.

1 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to recognize the stellar
2 career of General Vicente Blaz, known far and wide as Ben Blaz, by naming Route
3 3 consistently with Route 3’s connection to Marine Corps Base Camp Blaz and
4 Marine Corps Drive.

5 **Section 2.** A new § 849.15 is *added* to Article 1 of Chapter 8, Title 1, Guam
6 Code Annotated, to read as follows:

7 “**§ 849.15. Designation of Route 3 as BG ‘Ben Blaz Memorial**
8 **Highway.’**”

9 Route 3 is hereby designated as “BG Ben Blaz Memorial Highway.”
10 The Department of Public Works (Department) shall cause to be posted along
11 Route 3, at appropriate intersection locations, signs that visibly identify the
12 route’s official name as “BG Ben Blaz Memorial Highway.” The Department
13 shall further cause to be displayed along the roadside, at or near such
14 appropriate intersections, signage that dedicates the highway to honor the
15 distinguished service of the first son of Guam to attain a flag officer rank in
16 any of the branches of the armed forces of the United States. The Department
17 shall further cause to be fixed, prominently and in overhead display, such
18 signs at the intersection of Route 1 and Route 3, and the junction of Route 3A,
19 Route 9 and Route 3, which shall clearly designate Route 3 as “BG Ben Blaz
20 Memorial Highway.”

21 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon
22 enactment.
