2 Section 1. § 54B103(b) of Chapter 54B, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, is

"(b) Subsection (a) of this Section shall remain in effect until July 1, 2025, unless such business is an eating and drinking establishment, as defined in 26 GARR § 4404(f), with a valid sanitary permit issued by the Division of Environmental Health of the Department of Public Health and Social

9 Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

10 Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any 11 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall 12 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without 13 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are 14 severable.
