



**AN ACT TO TEMPORARILY WAIVE THE LEVY OF EXCISE TAXES, AUTOMOTIVE SURCHARGES, AND MASS TRANSIT AUTOMOTIVE SURCHARGES ON LIQUID FUEL FOR ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY (180) CALENDAR DAYS; TO *AMEND* SUBSECTION (j)(1) OF SECTION 1, CHAPTER V OF PUBLIC LAW 36-54, RELATIVE TO THE APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; AND TO *AMEND* SUBSECTION (dd)(1) OF SECTION 1, CHAPTER V OF PUBLIC LAW 36-54, RELATIVE TO THE APPROPRIATIONS TO THE GUAM REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY.**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1. Title.** This Act shall be known and may be cited as the *Gas Tax*

3   *Relief Act.*

1           **Section 2. Excise Tax on Liquid Fuel Temporarily Waived.** Except for  
2 liquid fuel used for commercial aviation purposes, the levy of excise taxes on liquid  
3 fuel pursuant to § 26402 of Article 4, Chapter 26, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated,  
4 shall be waived for the period that this Act is in effect.

5           **Section 3. Automotive Surcharge on Liquid Fuel Temporarily Waived.**  
6 The levy of automotive surcharges on liquid fuel pursuant to § 26502 of Article 5,  
7 Chapter 26, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, shall be waived for the period that this  
8 Act is in effect.

9           **Section 4. Mass Transit Automotive Surcharge on Liquid Fuel**  
10 **Temporarily Waived.** The levy of Mass Transit Automotive Surcharges on liquid  
11 fuel pursuant to § 26503(a) of Article 5, Chapter 26, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated,  
12 shall be waived for the period that this Act is in effect.

13           **Section 5.** Every person or business, whether engaged in the wholesale or  
14 retail of automotive fuel products and who are no longer subject to the levy of excise  
15 taxes, automotive surcharges, and mass transit automotive surcharges on liquid fuel,  
16 shall submit to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* and the Director of the  
17 Department of Revenue and Taxation a written declaration, under penalty of perjury,  
18 declaring that such relief or reduction from the levy of taxes and surcharges herein  
19 were in fact not collected from the consumer and are removed from the final cost of  
20 liquid fuel products for consumers. Such declaration shall be submitted monthly for  
21 the duration of the temporary waiver of taxes and surcharges herein.

22           **Section 6. Appropriations to the Department of Public Works**  
23 **Amended.** Subsection (j)(1) of Section 1, Chapter V of Public Law 36-54 is hereby  
24 *amended* to read:

25           “(j) **DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (DPW)**

26           (1) Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
27           sum of Nineteen Million Three Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Seven

1 Hundred Seven Dollars (**\$19,395,707**) is appropriated to the Department of  
2 Public Works (DPW) for its operations for Fiscal Year 2022. This sum is  
3 composed of Five Million Dollars (**\$5,000,000**) from the General Fund,  
4 Seven Million Five Hundred Thirty-seven Thousand One Hundred Eighty-  
5 three Dollars (**\$7,537,183**) from the Guam Highway Fund, and Six Million  
6 Eight Hundred Fifty-eight Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-four Dollars  
7 (**\$6,858,524**) from the Guam Educational Facilities Fund.

13 **Section 7. Appropriations to the Guam Regional Transit Authority**

14 **Amended.** Subsection (dd)(1) of Section 1, Chapter V of Public Law 36-54 is hereby  
15 *amended* to read:

16 **“(dd) Guam Regional Transit Authority (GRTA)**

17 (1) Appropriation. The sum of Two Million Six Hundred  
18 Ninety-four Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-One Dollars (**\$2,694,631**) is  
19 appropriated to the Guam Regional Transit Authority (GRTA) for its  
20 operations for Fiscal Year 2022. This sum composed of Two Million  
21 Five Hundred Fifty-three Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-five Dollars  
22 (**\$2,553,855**) from the General Fund, and One Hundred Forty Thousand  
23 Seven Hundred Seventy-six Dollars (**\$140,776**) from the Public Transit  
24 Fund.

To *add* a new Section 5 to the Bill to read:

“Every person or business, whether engaged in the wholesale or retail of automotive fuel products and who are no longer subject to the levy of excise taxes, automotive surcharges and Mass Transit automotive surcharges on liquid fuel shall, submit to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan and the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation, a written declaration, under penalty of perjury, declaring that such relief or reduction from the levy of taxes and surcharges herein were in fact not collected from the consumer and are removed from the final cost of liquid fuel products for consumers. Such declaration shall be submitted monthly for the duration of the temporary waiver of taxes and surcharges herein.”
