AN ACT TO TEMPORARILY WAIVE THE LEVY OF EXCISE TAXES, AUTOMOTIVE SURCHARGES, AND MASS TRANSIT AUTOMOTIVE SURCHARGES ON LIQUID FUEL FOR ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY (180) CALENDAR DAYS; TO AMEND SUBSECTION (j)(1) OF SECTION 1, CHAPTER V OF PUBLIC LAW 36-54, RELATIVE TO THE APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; AND TO AMEND SUBSECTION (dd)(1) OF SECTION 1, CHAPTER V OF **PUBLIC** LAW 36-54, RELATIVE TO THE APPROPRIATIONS TO THE **GUAM** REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 **Section 1.** Title. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the *Gas Tax*
- 3 Relief Act.

1	Section 2. Excise Tax on Liquid Fuel Temporarily Waived. Except for			
2	liquid fuel used for commercial aviation purposes, the levy of excise taxes on liquid			
3	fuel pursuant to § 26402 of Article 4, Chapter 26, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated,			
4	shall be waived for the period that this Act is in effect.			
5	Section 3. Automotive Surcharge on Liquid Fuel Temporarily Waived.			
6	The levy of automotive surcharges on liquid fuel pursuant to § 26502 of Article 5,			
7	Chapter 26, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, shall be waived for the period that this			
8	Act is in effect.			
9	Section 4. Mass Transit Automotive Surcharge on Liquid Fuel			
10	Temporarily Waived. The levy of Mass Transit Automotive Surcharges on liquid			
11	fuel pursuant to § 26503(a) of Article 5, Chapter 26, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated,			
12	shall be waived for the period that this Act is in effect.			
13	Section 5. Every person or business, whether engaged in the wholesale or			
14	retail of automotive fuel products and who are no longer subject to the levy of excise			
15	taxes, automotive surcharges, and mass transit automotive surcharges on liquid fuel,			
16	shall submit to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan and the Director of the			
17	Department of Revenue and Taxation a written declaration, under penalty of perjury,			
18	declaring that such relief or reduction from the levy of taxes and surcharges herein			
19	were in fact not collected from the consumer and are removed from the final cost of			
20	liquid fuel products for consumers. Such declaration shall be submitted monthly for			
21	the duration of the temporary waiver of taxes and surcharges herein.			
22	Section 6. Appropriations to the Department of Public Works

If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
