AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 849.16 TO ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 8, TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO DESIGNATING A PORTION OF ROUTE 4 AS “SEVEN HEROES OF MALESSO' HIGHWAY.”

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that toward the end of World War II, just days before American forces stormed the
4 beaches of Guam to end the Japanese occupation of the island, Japanese soldiers
5 escalated their atrocities against CHamorus. Such was the case on July 15 and 16,
6 1944 when nearly fifty (50) CHamoru men and women were massacred in the *Tinta*
7 and *Faha* areas of *Malessos*'. Many more would have been killed but for the heroic
8 actions of seven (7) brave men of *Malessos*' who risked their lives to prevent further

1 murders of their fellow villagers. The seven (7) heroes were Jose S. Reyes, Mariano
2 Nangauta, Jose Nangauta, Juan A. Naputi, Patricio Taijeron, Vicente Meno, and
3 Nicolas Chargualaf.

4 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* that it would be a fitting
5 tribute to these seven (7) Guam heroes that a portion of the highway in *Malessó'* be
6 named in memory of the brave men who risked all to save the lives of their family,
7 friends, and neighbors.

8 **Section 2.** A new § 849.16 is *added* to Article 1 of Chapter 8, Title 1, Guam
9 Code Annotated, to read as follows:

10 **“§ 849.16. Designation of a Portion of Route 4 as “Seven Heroes**
11 **of *Malessó'* Highway.”**

12 (a) The portion of Route 4 from the terminus of Route 2 in
13 Humåtak to the Ajayan River Bridge is hereby designated as “Seven
14 Heroes of *Malessó'* Highway.”

15 (b) The Director of the Department of Public Works shall
16 cause to have signs posted, at appropriate intervals, that visibly identify
17 the highway’s official name.

18 (c) All references within government of Guam documentation
19 and signage shall reflect this designation.”

20 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
