AN ACT TO AMEND § 51A106(a)(2) OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 51A, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO EXPANDING THE QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GUAM SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY GENERAL MANAGER POSITION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the Guam Solid Waste Authority (GSWA) Board of Directors has been searching for a General Manager since August 2020; and also finds that within the past eight (8) months, GSWA received several applications for the position from interested individuals, whose educational qualifications are not specifically listed in 6 the current GSWA statute. Therefore, I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to amend the minimum 8 qualifications for the GSWA General Manager position by expanding the type of

Section 2.	§ 51A106(a)(2) of Article 1, Chapter 51A, Title 10, Guam Code
Annotated, is here	by <i>amended</i> to read:

"(2) graduation from an accredited institution of higher education with a bachelor's degree in Business Management, Engineering Management, Engineering Technology, Civil Engineering, Environmental Science, Environmental Engineering, or a closely related field or discipline. If in the best interest of the Authority, the Board may consider other related industry trainings and certifications."

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
