AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 4124(b)(2) TO CHAPTER 4 OF TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO CREATING AN EXEMPTION FROM THE SERVICE-LEARNING REQUIREMENT FOR GRADUATING HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS FOR SCHOOL YEARS 2021-2022 AND 2022-2023.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that Public Law 30-53, codified at § 4124(b) of Chapter 4, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, requires Guam Department of Education high school students to complete seventy-five (75) hours of service learning in order to graduate from high school beginning with the ninth (9th) grade class during School Year 2011-2012.

I Liheslatura recognizes that the service-learning requirement as established requires students to actively participate in organized service activities. I Liheslatura further recognizes that due to the ongoing effects of the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) and the development of various new strains of the virus it has contributed to exacerbating the education of the island's students; and due to the

- ongoing global pandemic, many students continue to be unable to physically participate in these service activities.
- Thus, it is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to create an exemption for all graduating high school students for School Years 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 from the requirement set forth in 17 GCA § 4124(b).
- Section 2. A new § 4124(b)(2) is hereby *added* to Chapter 4 of Title 17,

 Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:
- 8 "(2) Graduating high school students for School Years 2021-2022 and 9 2022-2023 shall be exempt from the provisions of § 4124(b)."
- Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
- 15 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
