

**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 5141(n) TO SUBARTICLE E OF ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 5, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; AND *ADD* A NEW § 1924 TO CHAPTER 19 OF TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING GOVERNMENT OF GUAM AGENCIES TO SUBMIT A PROCUREMENT TRAINING COMPLIANCE REPORT TO THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTABILITY.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that according to the conclusion and recommendations in the OPA Report No. 20-09, Government of Guam Procurement Training and Certification Follow-up Audit, there is no entity monitoring the government of Guam's agency compliance with the procurement training.

Therefore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to follow said OPA Report recommendations by having all agencies submit a procurement compliance report to the Office of Public Accountability.

**Section 2.** A new § 5141(n) is hereby *added* to Subarticle E of Article 2, Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

1           “(n) Procurement Training Compliance Report.

2           (1) Timeline for Submission. No later than thirty (30) days  
3 after the end of each fiscal year, every director, administrator, president  
4 or head of a government of Guam agency, including line agencies,  
5 autonomous and semi-autonomous agencies, public corporations, the  
6 Mayors Council of Guam, the Courts of the Judiciary of Guam, and *I*  
7 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* shall electronically submit to the Public Auditor  
8 of Guam, in an electronic portable document format, a “Procurement  
9 Training Compliance Report.”

10          (2) Content Guidelines. Said report shall at minimum list the  
11 employees by name, job title, each procurement training module  
12 completed, and the date of completion.”

13          **Section 3.** A new § 1924 is hereby *added* to Chapter 19 of Title 1, Guam  
14 Code Annotated, to read as follows:

15           “**§ 1924. Procurement Training Compliance Report.**

16           The Public Auditor of Guam shall receive and maintain Procurement  
17 Training Compliance Reports, submitted pursuant to 5 GCA § 5141(n), in an  
18 electronic portable document format.”

19          **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any  
20 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall  
21 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without  
22 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are  
23 severable.
