AN ACT TO AMEND § 403(h) OF CHAPTER 4, TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO CHANGING THE OFFICIAL NAME OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF "INARAJAN" TO ITS NAME IN THE CHAMORU LANGUAGE, NAMELY "INALÅHAN."

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. § 403(h) of Chapter 4, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby
- 3 *amended* to read:

"(h) Municipality of *Inalåhan*. Beginning at the mouth of the Talofofo River running easterly, southerly and southwesterly along the southeastern coastline to the mouth of the Ajayan River, thence northwesterly along said river to the Mt. Sasalaguan Triangulation Station, thence northwesterly to Mt. Bolanos Triangulation Station, thence northeasterly and southeasterly along the northern boundary of Estate No. 322 (Atate) to the point of its intersection with the Ugum River, thence northeasterly along the Ugum and Talofofo Rivers to the point of beginning."

Section 2. All references to "*Inarajan*" in the Guam Code Annotated and the laws, rules, and regulations of Guam shall be understood to refer to "*Inalåhan*."
