**AN ACT TO *AMEND* SUBSECTIONS (a)(4), (c)(1), (d)(2), AND (d)(4), ALL OF § 7120.1, CHAPTER 7, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REMOVING THE EXPIRATION DATE ON PERMANENT REMOVABLE WINDSHIELD PLACARDS AND EXTENDING THE PERIOD OF TIME FOR PHYSICIAN CERTIFICATION OF TEMPORARY REMOVABLE WINDSHIELD PLACARDS.**

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1.** § 7120.1(a)(4) of Chapter 7, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, is  
3 hereby *amended* to read:

4                “(4) Permanent removable windshield placard means a two (2)-sided,  
5 hanger style placard which includes on each side:

1 (A) the International Symbol of Accessibility, which is at least  
2 three inches (3”) in height, centered on the placard, and is white on a  
3 blue shield;

4 (B) an identification number; and

5 (C) the seal or other identification of the issuing authority.”

6 **Section 2.** § 7120.1(c)(1) of Chapter 7, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, is  
7 hereby *amended* to read:

8 “(c) Permanent Removable Windshield Placards.

9 (1) The Department of Revenue and Taxation (Motor Vehicle  
10 Division) shall provide for the issuance of permanent removable windshield  
11 placards, upon the applications of qualified persons with disabilities, when  
12 such disabilities are certified as permanent by a licensed physician or by a  
13 licensed optometrist if the disability is a visual impairment. The Department  
14 shall, upon request, issue no more than one (1) permanent removable  
15 windshield placard in addition to the issuance of a special license plate and  
16 shall, upon request, issue no more than two (2) placards to each applicant who  
17 does not have a special license plate. Such placards issued shall not expire.  
18 The Department shall not charge a fee for issuance of the placards.”

19 **Section 3.** § 7120.1(d)(2) of Chapter 7, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, is  
20 hereby *amended* to read:

21 “(2) The Department of Revenue and Taxation (Motor Vehicle  
22 Department) shall require that the application be accompanied by the  
23 certification of a licensed physician that the applicant meets the 16 GCA §  
24 7120.1(a)(2) definition of a qualified person with a disability, except that a  
25 licensed optometrist may certify a visual impairment as defined in §  
26 7120.1(a)(2)(F). The certification shall also include the period of time that the

1 physician or optometrist determines the applicant will have the disability, not  
2 to exceed twelve (12) months.”

3 **Section 4.** § 7120.1(d)(4) of Chapter 7, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, is  
4 hereby *amended* to read:

5 “(4) Each temporary removable windshield placard shall be valid for  
6 a period of time for which the physician or optometrist has determined that  
7 the applicant will have the disability, not to exceed twelve (12) months from  
8 the date of issuance. If the temporary disability extends beyond the expiration  
9 date of the placard, the applicant may reapply for a temporary removable  
10 windshield placard. The applicant, upon reapplication, shall submit another  
11 physician's or optometrist’s certification, and the placard shall be valid for a  
12 period of time for which the physician or optometrist has determined that the  
13 applicant will continue to have the disability, not to exceed twelve (12)  
14 months from the date of issuance.”

15 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

16 **Section 6. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any  
17 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall  
18 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without  
19 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are  
20 severable.
