AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (c) AND TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (d) TO § 66212 OF ARTICLE 2, BOTH OF CHAPTER 66, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ENCOURAGING THE CONSTRUCTION OF HOMES BY EXTENDING THE VALIDITY OF A BUILDING PERMIT FOR A PERIOD OF TWELVE (12) MONTHS AND GRANTING EXTENSIONS OF SUCH PERIOD FOR CAUSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 66212(c) of Article 2, Chapter 66, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

"(c) Any building permit shall lapse and be void if the work authorized by it is not commenced within twelve (12) months after its issuance; or is suspended or abandoned for a period of twelve (12) months at any time after the work has been commenced; provided, that, for cause, the building official may grant four (4) extensions of up to a maximum of three (3) months each. All such extensions shall be in writing and noted on the

1	building permit and in the building records of the Department of Public
2	Works."

- **Section 2.** A new § 66212(d) of Article 2 is hereby *added* to Chapter 66 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, to read:
- "(d) Should any discrepancy or conflict exist between the adopted codes pursuant to Chapter 67 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, and any subsection of § 66212 of Chapter 66, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, the subsection of § 66212 of Chapter 66, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, shall take precedence."
 - **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
- **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
