AN ACT TO AMEND § 4703(d)(1) AND (2) AND § 4703(g) OF ARTICLE 7, CHAPTER 4, TITLE 12, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO INCREASING THE THRESHOLD OF THE PURCHASE OF A HOME FROM THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000) TO THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$375,000), EXCLUDING OTHER COSTS IMPOSED ON THE PURCHASE OF A HOME, AND REMOVING THE FIVE (5) YEAR LIMITATION ON ADJUSTING THE ELIGIBLE TRANSACTION AMOUNT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

1 §§ 4703(d)(1) and (2) of Article 7, Chapter 4, Title 12, Guam Section 1. 2 Code Annotated, are hereby *amended* to read: 3 "(d) Eligible Transactions. An eligible transaction is: 4 (1)a contract made for the purchase of a home in Guam not 5 to exceed Three Hundred Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$375,000), 6 and shall not include down payment and closing costs; 7 (2)a comprehensive home building contract made by the owner of land in Guam, or a person who will on completion of the 8 9 contract be the owner of land in Guam, to have a home built on the land 10 not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$375,000), and shall not include down payment, land, and closing 11 12 costs;" Section 2. § 4703(g) of Article 7, Chapter 4, Title 12, Guam Code 13 14 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read: 15 Eligible Transaction Amount Adjustment. The Board shall from "(g) 16 time to time, conduct a study to determine the cost of the median price of 17 housing on Guam, and shall by resolution adopted by the Board increase or 18 decrease the amount of the eligible transaction to reflect changes in market price." 19 Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment and 20 Section 3. 21 shall be retroactive to January 1, 2020. Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any 22 23 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall 24 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without 25 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are 26 severable.

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
