AN ACT TO AMEND § 8104(a)(5)(A) AND § 8104(a)(5)(B), TO RENUMBER § 8104(a)(5)(C) AS § 8104(a)(5)(D); AND TO ADD A NEW §8104(a)(5)(C), ALL OF CHAPTER 8, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE TO MODERNIZING PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE REQUIREMENTS BY AUTHORIZING THE POSTING OF PUBLIC NOTICES IN LOCALLY LICENSED ELECTRONIC NEWSPAPERS AND WEBSITES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 8104(a)(5)(A) of Chapter 8, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

"(5)(A) Public Notice, as used in this Chapter, means a publication by
newspaper of general circulation or by radio or television another eligible media
platform, which is reasonably calculated to provide notice of the facts it announces
to the public at large, and by electronic publication on the Guam Public Notice
Website.

Section 2. § 8104(a)(5)(B) of Chapter 8, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated, is
 amended to read:

"(B) As used in this item, newspaper of general circulation means a 3 newspaper which is printed and distributed not less than once a week, at regular 4 intervals, throughout the territory of Guam, which has a paid circulation and holds a 5 valid second class mailing permit from the United States Post Office, and which 6 7 contains news, articles of opinion, features, and other matters of current interest published for public dissemination. A newspaper licensed to do business on Guam, 8 which publishes an edition electronically no less than once a week, also qualifies as 9 a newspaper of general circulation for the purpose of this Section. 10

Section 3. A new § 8104(a)(5)(C) of Chapter 8, Title 5 Guam Code
Annotated, is *amended* to read:

(C) As used in this item, *eligible media platform* means a radio or television 13 station or website which contains news, articles of opinion, features, and other 14 matters of current interest published for public dissemination. A television channel, 15 where the broadcast content is controlled or determined by the government of 16 Guam, its branches, agencies, instrumentalities or public corporations, is also an 17 eligible a media platform, provided the channel is available in the basic tier of at 18 least two (2) cable or internet-based television services (IPTV), except in the event 19 Guam has fewer than two (2) telecommunications companies that offer such 20 consumer television packages. Any radio or television station, or website must be a 21 component of a company that is licensed to do business on Guam to be an eligible 22 media platform. 23 (D) Government entities that access cable channels shall also be required to 24

25 broadcast public notices on that channel for that respective branch of government.
