1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS, *I Mina'Trentai Siette Na Liheslaturan Guahan,*** on behalf of the
4 people of Guam, join the rest of the nation in remembering the horrific attacks
5 against our country which occurred on September 11, 2001; and

6 **WHEREAS,** nearly three thousand (3,000) innocent civilians were killed in
7 the heinous attacks of September 11, 2001; and twenty-one (21) years later, the
8 people of the United States and from around the world continue to mourn the
9 tremendous loss of innocent lives on that fateful day; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Rotary Club of Northern Guam was established on
11 November 12, 1975, and has a membership of dedicated, community-oriented Guam
12 residents; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the mission of the Rotary International the parent organization
14 of which the Rotary Club of Northern Guam is a Charter member within District

1 2750, is to provide service to others, promote integrity, and advance world
2 understanding, goodwill, and peace through its fellowship of business, professional,
3 and community leaders; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Rotary Club of Northern Guam has consistently fulfilled this
5 mission by contributing to our island community in positive ways over the past 36
6 years, including providing students with scholarships to attend the University of
7 Guam and Guam Community College, and developing numerous community
8 projects not only on Guam but also throughout Micronesia and the larger Asia-
9 Pacific region; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the Rotary Peace Community Program is an international
11 initiative to develop alliances between local Rotary Clubs, community leaders, local
12 governments, and other community agencies in making a declaration of Community
13 Peace; and

14 **WHEREAS**, following the tragic events of September 11, 2001, the Rotary
15 Club of Northern Guam committed itself to developing a Peace Memorial to
16 memorialize and honor the many lives lost, and to, in the spirit of the Rotary Peace
17 Community Program, serve as a healing statement of Community Peace; and

18 **WHEREAS**, on September 12, 2002, the Rotary Club of Northern Guam,
19 under then-President Ed Cruz, held a groundbreaking ceremony for the Peace
20 Memorial to be located at Two Lover's Point; and,

21 **WHEREAS**, on this September 11, 2022, the Rotary Club of Northern Guam
22 held its Peace Memorial honoring all the lives lost and impacted by the events of
23 September 11, 2001, and, in so doing, providing a space to reflect upon opportunities
24 to promote peace throughout the community; and now therefore, be it

25 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Siette Na*
26 *Lihe slaturan Guahan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihe slaturan Guahan* and the
27 people of Guam, recognize the observance of September 11, 2022, in honor of the

1 victims of the attacks on the United States; and further commend the Rotary Club of
2 Northern Guam for honoring the lives lost and promoting peace through our
3 community; and be it further

4 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
5 Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that
6 copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Rotary Club of Northern Guam,
7 the Rotary Club of Northern Guam President, Ms. Ina Lee, and the Honorable
8 Lourdes A. Leon Guererro, *I Maga'hagan Guahan*.
