

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I* 2 *MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

WHEREAS, Guam's Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 668 was formed and recognized as a chapter on December 20, 1993, by Vietnam Veterans of America (VAA), a national non-profit corporation founded in 1978 in the United States that is

1 committed to serving the needs of all veterans, and is funded without any contributions 2 from any branch of the government; and

WHEREAS, the Vietnam Veterans of America is the only such organization 3 chartered by the United States Congress dedicated to Vietnam veterans and their 4 5 families. The VVA holds a Congressional Charter under Title 36 of the United States 6 Code and their founding principle is "Never again shall one generation of veterans 7 abandon another." This ensures that veterans who have served our country receive the care and the respect they have earned and deserve for this generation of veterans and 8 9 the next; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the VVA campaigns on issues important to Vietnam veterans to create a new identity for this generation of veterans, and to improve public perception 11 12 of Vietnam veterans. The organization's main efforts concern including a Government 13 Relations Advocacy on veterans' issues, a National Task Force for Homeless Veterans, 14 health care for veterans, including disabled veterans, issues pertaining to women and 15 minority veterans, a national scholarship fund, assisting veterans seeking 16 benefits/services from the government, and organizing "Stand Downs" for the hard to reach homeless veteran in need of services. VVA has organizing councils in 43 states, 17 some 650 local chapters, and more than 85,000 individual members; and 18
