WHEREAS, the symbols on the Club Logo each have their own meaning: the Chain symbolizes the ability to move freely with support; the Cloud represents a gentle cushion to move about in their independence; and the Children represents the uniqueness of each child; and

WHEREAS, the Club's slogan is "*Isan Famagu'on*," and the Club's motto is: "*We Serve (Ta Setbe)*"; and the *Guåhan Isan Famagu'on* Lions Club promotes the LEO and CUB programs in helping children to develop skills to enhance their growth in being future leaders in Lionism; and

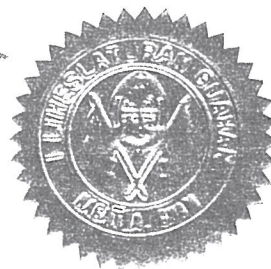
