3 WHEREAS, *†*Jesse Finona Balajadia, also known as 4 "Jess/Pops/Chumbai/Nunu", Familian Piyu from the village of Yoña passed away on 5 February 1, 2024, at the age of 50. Jesse was the son of <sup>†</sup>Vicente Pangelinan Balajadia 6 and †Manuela Finona Balajadia; husband of Angela Marie Camacho Balajadia and his 7 children are Andrew, Jessilyn, Jasmine; and

8 WHEREAS, †Jesse coaching career began in 1997 for the Sinajana Giants 9 Baseball Organization and coached for the Majors, Juniors, Seniors Divisions; the 10 Sinajana Giants Baseball Organization for nine (9) years; and

WHEREAS, †Jesse played for the Yona Master Baseball Team, the Agana
Heights 76 Cougars Masters Team, the Yona RedHawks Masters Team, the Sindalu
Guahan 50's Masters Softball Team and also played in Las Vegas, Nevada; and

WHEREAS, In 2005, †Jesse coached the Team Guam Baseball All-Stars, Senior
 Division in Jakarta, Indonesia; and

WHEREAS, †Jesse was the Central Division Baseball All-Stars in the village of
 Barrigada in 2006; Head Coach for the Girls Fastpitch Softball All-Star Team for the
 Majors Division competing at Pasig City, Philippines in 2007; and Head Coach for the
 Baseball Juniors Division competing Guangzhou, China in 2006; and

WHEREAS, †Jesse's baseball career led him to be the Head Coach of the Juniors
Division in the village of Tamuning and in 2010, he became the Manager of the Majors
Division and led his team to compete in Jakarta, Indonesia; he continued being a
Manager for the Juniors Division in 2011 and brought the Guam team to compete in
Bacolod, Philippines; and

WHEREAS, †Jesse moved up to the Big League Division as a manager in 2013
and led Guam to compete in Clark Pampanga, Philippines and was the Asia Pacific
Region World Series Senior League Softball Team Manager in 2015 and led the team
to compete in Roxana, Delaware; and

WHEREAS, †Jesse coached the Southern Highs School (SHS) Dolphins Softball team for twelve (12) years; led the Southern High Dolphins to win the Championship 4 times in a row. †Jesse's coaching skills reflected well leading the Southern High Dolphins to win the Championship games in 2016 and 2020 and he coached the Southern Highschool Dolphins in the APL Fastpitch Softball League in 2018 and 2019, leading them to become back-to-back Champions for the league; and

WHEREAS, †Jesse was the founder, Coach and Manager the MTM Lady
Falcons Fastpitch Softball Team, Yona Lady Hawks Fastpitch Softball Organization,
and the Yona Lady Dodgers Fastpitch Softball Organization for nine (9) years; and

WHEREAS, †Jesse founded the Smokin' Hot Softball Team in 2017 to 2024; played in the 2020 Pure Play International Slow-pitch Tournament Coed A Division Champions in Clark Pampanga, Philippines; and in 2023, he was the Coach for the Asia Cup Championships Women's Division that took place in Bangkok, Thailand and won the Championship title, being recognized by the 37<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature for their accomplishment and representing Guam on a National level and were presented
 certificates on November 30, 2023, at the Guam Congress Building; and

WHEREAS, †Jesse's love for baseball and his family showed in his coaching,
dedication, time and sacrifice and he shared his love for baseball with his children, and
coached while they played for youth baseball; now therefore, be it
