3 **WHEREAS**, building on the success of National Apprenticeship Week,
4 Youth Apprenticeship Week (YAW) is a nationwide celebration that highlight the
5 benefits and value of Registered Apprenticeship Program for youth, ages 16-24; and

6 **WHEREAS**, employers, educators, labor unions, workforce professionals,
7 and their partners across the nation are launching Registered Apprenticeship
8 programs that allow youth to earn competitive wages while obtaining the relevant
9 training and experience to start their careers; and

10 **WHEREAS**, YAW is an opportunity for these community partners and
11 stakeholders to host events across the island, to bring awareness of life-changing

1 apprenticeship career opportunities for youth and how they create a sustainable
2 pipeline of skilled and diverse talent for the jobs of today and tomorrow for critical
3 industries; and

4 **WHEREAS**, there are two models of Youth Apprenticeship Programs, which
5 most programs fall into one of the two types of models: Pre-Apprenticeship Program
6 for Youth, which prepares students to enter a registered Apprenticeship Program and
7 Registered Apprenticeship Programs that begin in high school, community college,
8 or dual enrollment opportunities, which allow a youth to start their apprenticeship,
9 while still a student; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Apprenticeship Programs opens the door of possibilities for our
11 island youths, it lifts them up to new heights and make their success for future good-
12 paying jobs with dignity and respect; and therefore, be it

13 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Siette Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
14 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize May 5-11, 2024 as “Youth
15 Apprenticeship Week”; and to further express an earnest appreciation to the many
