3 **WHEREAS, the late †John Joseph Aguon, from the village of Yona, was born**

1 **WHEREAS**, the late †John Joseph Aguon is a brother to Vanessa and Roman
2 Dueñas, Barbara Aguon and Nateesha Mendiola, Vince Aguon and Matthew Libby, and
3 Venancio Jr. and Jovie Aguon, the loving husband of Leticia Renee Aguon, and the
4 father of Jonishia, Jiana and Jordan, Mya and Matthew, Malysa and George, Matthew
5 and Carolyn, Jesse and Tanya, Shaunalyn, Thomas and Jonessa, and Irene and Nathan;

7 **WHEREAS**, the late †John Joseph Aguon is the grandfather of nine (9)

10 **WHEREAS**, prior to serving the island through the Guam Customs and
11 Quarantine Agency (CQA), the late †John Joseph Aguon attended and graduated from
12 the Guam Community College in 1991, served our country and joined the United States
13 Army from 1991 to 1995, and then moved on to the United States Army Reserves from
14 1995 to 1997; and

15 **WHEREAS**, on November 27, 1995, the late †John Joseph Aguon joined the
16 CQA, serving the agency and the island of Guam for twenty-nine (29) years and
17 attaining the rank of Captain before being posthumously promoted to Assistant Chief
18 of Customs and Quarantine, Colonel; and

19 **WHEREAS**, outside of his service and dedication to the Guam CQA, the late
20 †John Joseph Aguon was an avid vehicle enthusiast, being a member of the Increase
21 The Peace Auto Club and participating in car shows and events, and was a committed
22 member of our community by volunteering his time for typhoon recovery efforts; now
23 therefore be it
