RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING PATRICK JAMES FLORES UNCANGCO. FOR HIS EXTRAORDINARY BRAVERY AND CIVIC RESPONSIBILITY BY APPREHENDING A TRAFFIC ASSAILANT WHO WAS LATER FOUND TO BE WANTED BY THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR MULTIPLE CRIMES.

- WHEREAS, on June 22, 2024, Patrick James Flores Uncangco
- 4 demonstrated extraordinary bravery and civic responsibility in Dededo, Guam, on
- 5 Macheche Road; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mr. Uncangco witnessed a man, recklessly driving a white
- 7 small crossover SUV; and

1	WHEREAS, the assailant was speeding and attempting to pass several
2	cars, ultimately losing control and nearly endangering pedestrian lives, before veering
3	into oncoming traffic, hitting a pole and flipping his SUV within five feet of Patrick
4	Uncangco's truck; and
5	WHEREAS, despite the danger, Patrick Uncangco acted swiftly and
6	decisively when the assailant attempted to flee the scene, successfully apprehending
7	him and holding him until the Guam Police Department (GPD) arrived; and
8	WHEREAS, according to the GPD, the driver who was detained by
9	Mr. Uncangco following a car crash in Dededo Saturday was armed with a gun and
10	was using a stolen car.
11	WHEREAS, the assailant was arrested on suspicion of theft of motor
12	vehicle, illegal possession of a firearm, unlawful discharge, reckless conduct,
13	terrorizing, destruction of evidence, reckless driving, leaving the scene of a crash
14	with property damage, and execution of a search warrant; and
15	WHEREAS, the driver had been on the run from authorities and was
16	wanted in connection to last month's shooting in Maite that left a teenage girl injured;
17	and
18	WHEREAS, investigators said the shooting was among a handful of other
19	violent crimes reported in recent months believed to be gang-related; and
20	WHEREAS, Mr. Uncangco is a good Samaritan and a lifelong martial
21	artist, using his skill set to detain the assailant and keep him from fleeing the scene
22	until police arrived; and
23	WHEREAS, Patrick Uncangco's courageous actions not only resulted in
24	the capture of a repeat offender but also significantly contributed to the safety and
25	well-being of the community; now therefore, be it
