1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** †Chief Master Sergeant Leo C. Osborne was born on October 3,
4 1946, in Louisa, Kentucky, and graduated from Louisa High School in 1966; and

5 **WHEREAS,** †Chief Master Sergeant Osborne enlisted in the United States Air
6 Force in November 1966 and, following graduation from Basic Training, attended
7 technical training as a Materiel Facilities Specialist in Amarillo, Texas; and

8 **WHEREAS,** †Chief Master Sergeant Osborne's distinguished military career
9 included assignments at Clark A.B. Philippines, Altus AFB Oklahoma, Cape Romanzof
10 Air Force Station Alaska, Cannon AFB New Mexico, Kadena AB Japan, Vandenburg
11 AFB California, RAF Wethersfield England, Andersen AFB Guam, RAF Lakenheath,
12 England, and Eglin AFB Florida; and

13 **WHEREAS,** †Chief Master Sergeant's notable military achievements include
14 serving as NCOIC of various sections, Superintendent of Procedures and Analysis

1 Element, Chief of Supply, and Manager of Materiel Management Flight, among other
2 critical leadership roles; and

3 **WHEREAS,** †Chief Master Sergeant Osborne completed the Noncommissioned
4 Officer Leadership School, the Pacific Air Command Noncommissioned Officer
5 Academy, and the Senior Noncommissioned Officer Academy, demonstrating his
6 commitment to professional development; and

7 **WHEREAS,** †Chief Master Sergeant Osborne’s military decorations include the
8 Meritorious Service Medal with five oak leaf clusters, the Air Force Commendation
9 Medal with three oak leaf clusters, the Air Force Achievement Medal with two oak leaf
10 clusters, the Air Force Good Conduct Medal with one silver and two oak leaf clusters,
11 and the National Defense Service Medal with one bronze star; and

12 **WHEREAS,** †Chief Master Sergeant Osborne has also dedicated his life to
13 service in his faith, being called to preach in 1965, and subsequently serving in various
14 capacities such as Site Chaplain at Cape Romanzof, Alaska, and Interim Pastor,
15 Associate Pastor, and Missionary Pastor, in multiple locations, including Berean Baptist
16 Church in California, Finchingfield Baptist Church in England, and Freedom Baptist
17 Church in Guam; and

18 **WHEREAS,** †Chief Master Sergeant Osborne’s faith journey began with his
19 salvation during a revival meeting in 1965, and since then, he has faithfully answered
20 the call to preach, leading numerous individuals to Christ and serving in various
21 ministry roles, including Youth Director, Sunday School Teacher, and Nursing Home
22 Ministry Director; and

23 **WHEREAS,** †Chief Master Sergeant Osborne, alongside his wife of 57 years
24 Rosario J. Osborne and their children Ben Thomas and Maria Louise, has shown
25 unwavering commitment to both his country and his faith, serving as a beacon of
26 leadership, integrity, and devotion; and

1 **WHEREAS**, †Chief Master Sergeant Osborne’s lifetime of service and
2 dedication has left a lasting impact on both the military community and the faith
3 communities he has served; now therefore, be it

4 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Siette Na*
5 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, commend †Chief
6 Master Sergeant Leo C. Osborne for his exemplary military service and devoted faith
7 service, recognizing his significant contributions to his country, his community, and
8 everyday people seeking to better know the love of Christ; and be it further
