WHEREAS, Victim Advocates Reaching Out (VARO) is a non-profit organization founded in 1982 by the Guam Task Force on Family Abuse and Sexual Assault, with the mission of providing crisis support, including domestic violence, sexual assault, child abuse, human trafficking, and other forms of violence and trauma that affect individuals and families on Guam; and

WHEREAS, VARO was established in response to the growing need for victim advocacy services on the island, recognizing that victims of crime often face significant emotional, psychological, and financial challenges in the aftermath of their experiences; and
