WHEREAS, it is the sense of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to recognize the life and accomplishments of those distinguished citizens of this great island who have devoted themselves to faithfully serving the best interests of our community and the needs of our people; and

WHEREAS, one such distinguished citizen is Dr. Jonathan E. Sidell is an
accomplished Obstetrics and Gynecology (OB-GYN) specialist who has dedicated over
thirty-five (35) years to the medical profession, with nearly two decades of service on
Guam, positively impacting the island's healthcare system; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sidell began his academic journey at San Joaquin Delta College
in Stockton, California, from 1979 to 1982, and then continued his studies at the
University of California, Santa Barbara, where he graduated with Highest Honors in
1984 with a Bachelor of Arts in Biology; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sidell pursued his medical education at Wayne State University
School of Medicine in Detroit, Michigan, earning his Doctor of Medicine in 1989. He
then completed his transitional internship at Sacred Heart Medical Center from 1989 to
1990, followed by his residency in OB-GYN at Interfaith Medical Center in Brooklyn,
New York, and State University of New York from 1992 to 1996, including rotations
at Kings County Hospital Center; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sidell has demonstrated exceptional academic prowess throughout his career, including being awarded the San Joaquin Medical Society Scholarship, graduating with Highest Honors from the University of California, and achieving the top 90th percentile in his National Boards in 1990 and the 95th percentile in the Council on Resident Education in Obstetrics and Gynecology (CREOG) exam; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sidell has been a dedicated researcher, with significant contributions to topics such as "Estimating Mgso4 Levels by Cr. Clearance" and "Activities of Daily Living as an Indicator of Domestic Violence," showcasing his commitment to advancing medical knowledge and improving patient care; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sidell has been licensed to practice medicine in Oregon from
18 1990 to 2003 and on Guam from 2003 to the present, earning his Diplomate of the
American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology from 1997 to 2008; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sidell joined the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) on June 14, 2005, where he has served with distinction in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, holding numerous leadership roles, including Department Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson, President and Past President of the Medical Executive Committee, and key executive leadership roles such as Medical Director, Chief Medical Officer (CMO), and Acting Associate Administrator of Medical Services; and WHEREAS, during his tenure at GMHA, Dr. Sidell has provided invaluable
 contributions to the hospital's operations, patient care, and medical staff development,
 and his guidance has been instrumental during critical periods, such as the COVID-19
 pandemic, Typhoon Mawar, and ongoing health system improvements; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sidell has also been affiliated with other medical institutions,
including serving as Chief Medical Officer at Mountain View Hospital, practicing as a
hospitalist at Guam Medical Center, and running successful private practices in Madras
and Coos Bay, Oregon, before relocating to Guam; and
