3 **WHEREAS,** First Sergeant Sanchez is the daughter of Sylvia Cruz and Joseph
4 Sanchez and mother to Jontae; and

5 **WHEREAS,** First Sergeant Sanchez graduated from Guam Community College
6 High School in 1988; and

7 **WHEREAS,** First Sergeant Sanchez enlisted in the Army in February of 2000
8 and attended Basic Combat Training in Fort Jackson, North Carolina and 92G Culinary
9 Advanced Individual Training in Fort Lee, Virginia ; and

10 **WHEREAS,** First Sergeant Sanchez's assignments include 368th Military Police
11 Company; 1101st Garrison Support Unit Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting
12 System (DEERS) Noncommissioned Officer (NCO); 1101st Garrison Support Ammo
13 Supply Point Noncommissioned Officer in Charge (NCOIC); 368th Military Police
14 Headquarters Platoon Sergeant and 368th Military Police 92G NCOIC; Regional
15 Support Group S4 NCO; Theater Support Group-Pacific, Fort Shafter Flats in Honolulu,
16 Hawaii; United States Army Reserve (USAR) Theater Support Group Detachment
17 Marians NCOIC; First Sergeant 658th Regional Support Group Headquarters and

3 **WHEREAS**, First Sergeant Sanchez’s duty positions include Team Leader,

9 Course among many others; and

10 **WHEREAS**, First Sergeant Sanchez also completed Criminal Justice Courses
11 including Criminal Investigation, Criminal Law, Criminal Procedures, Defensive
12 Tactics, First Responder, Officer Survival and Juvenile Justice; and
