## 1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I* 2 MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Kiwanis is a global organization of volunteers dedicated to improving the world one child and one community at a time; and

WHEREAS, Kiwanis will be a positive influence in communities worldwide, so that one day, all children will wake up in communities that believe in them, nurture them and provide the support they need to thrive; and

WHEREAS, Kiwanis' objectives are to give primacy to the human and spiritual, rather than to the material values of life; To encourage the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships; To promote the adoption and the application of higher social, business and professional standards; To develop, by precept and example, a more intelligent, aggressive and serviceable citizenship; To provide, through Kiwanis clubs, a practical means to form enduring friendships, to render altruistic service and to build better communities; To cooperate in creating and maintaining that sound public opinion and high idealism which make possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism and goodwill; and

1 WHEREAS, Kiwanis International was founded in 1915 in Detroit, Michigan, 2 U.S. as the Supreme Lodge Benevolent Order of Brothers. A year later, the name 3 changed to Kiwanis, which was selected by the organization's founders based on their understanding that the word was translatable to "we build" from the Algonquian Native 4 5 American language family. That same year, Kiwanis became an international 6 organization with the founding of the Kiwanis Club of Hamilton, Ontario, Canada; and 7 **WHEREAS**, initially focused on business networking, the organization changed its focus to service in 1919 — specifically service to children. Over the years, more 8 9 clubs were created in the U.S. and Canada, and worldwide expansion was ultimately 10 approved in the 1960s. Today, there are Kiwanis clubs in nearly 80 nations and 11 geographic locations; and WHEREAS, Kiwanis clubs and members conduct service projects, hold 12 13 fundraisers, donate to the Kiwanis Children's Fund, and change children's lives in their 14 own communities and through international initiatives — helping young people develop 15 mentally, physically, and emotionally; and 16 **WHEREAS,** every year, Kiwanis members stage more than 1.3 million service projects and raise nearly US\$390 million for children, families, and communities 17 18 around the world. Kiwanis club projects are based on the community's needs — we build playgrounds, purchase medical equipment, stuff backpacks with school supplies, 19 20 restock libraries, and much more. The average Kiwanian makes an impact on the lives 21 of 106 children; and WHEREAS, Kiwanis Asia-Pacific (ASPAC) consists of Kiwanis Districts, 22 23 Provisional Districts, and non-districted Nations in the Asia-Pacific Region and the 24 Kiwanis Guåhan Familia received its charter on October 24, 2023; and 25 WHEREAS, Kiwanis Guåhan Familia's officers are Charter President Allan 26 Camacho, President-Elect Ambrosio Constantino, Second Vice President Gloria 27 Mariano, Secretary Maria Duque, and Treasurer Leonara Calma; and

1	WHEREAS, Kiwanis Guåhan Familia's community involvement this year							
2	includes purchasing paint for Agueda Johnson Middle School as well as providing funds							
3	for the school choir's uniforms; providing water for various school sports teams, and							
4	supporting the Special Olympics with water distribution; supporting the Department of							
5	Public Health and Social Services Child Abuse Prevention 2K/5K Walk Run Race with							
6	registration assistance; supporting a literacy reading campaign by having Kiwanis							
7	volunteers reading to elementary school students; providing toys, clothes and children's							
8	books to the Harvest House Christmas Drive event; partnering with the Red Cross in							
9	providing home fire prevention training to students at Liguan Elementary School							
10	paying the school's league entrance fees for their soccer, kickball and volleyball teams							
11	and assisting with the purchase of a portable basketball rim; now therefore, be it							
12	RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'trentai Siette Na							
13	Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize Kiwanis							
14	Guåhan Familia on the occasion of their One (1) Year Anniversary and commend them
