COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Environment, Revenue and Taxation, Labor, Procurement, and Statistics, Research, and Planning convened a public hearing on May 18, 2023, at 11:00 a.m. in the Guam Congress Building, Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Mr. Jason W. Baza to serve as a Member of the Guam Banking and Insurance Board, of whose appointment is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero on April 13, 2023, to serve from May 6, 2019 to May 5, 2025
- Appointment packet was forwarded to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* on April 19, 2023.
- Appointment packet forwarded to this Committee for public consideration on April 21, 2023.

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all Senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on May 11, 2023, and again on May 16, 2023, fulfilling the 5-Day Notice and 48-Hour Notice of the Open Government Law requirements respectively.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 11:00 a.m.

Senator Sabina Flores Perez, Chairperson: Buenas and Håfa adai. The Committee on Environment, Revenue and Taxation, Labor, and Statistics, Research, and Planning is calling its public hearing to order. The time now is 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 18th, 2023.

In compliance with Open Government Law. Notices of the day's hearing were published in the Guam Daily Post, provided via email to senators, stakeholders, the local media, and posted to the

Government of Guam Public Notices Website on Thursday, May 11th, 2023, for the 5-Day Notice, and Tuesday, May 16th, 2023, for the 48-hour Notice.

The purpose of this public hearing is to receive testimony on the following items:

- Executive Appointment of Ms. Alexandria "Sandy" Gould Yow to serve as a Member of the Guam Real Estate Commission.
- Executive Appointment of Mr. Jason W. Baza to serve as a Member of the Guam Banking and Insurance Board.
- Executive Re-Appointment of Mr. Steven R. Hollister to serve as Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency, Board of Directors.

The rules of conduct for today's hearing are as follows:

- (1) Those called to testify will be in the order beginning with those that called in advance with my office on Monday, May 15th, 2023, followed by the order according to the sign in sheet.
- (2) Individuals testifying today are asked to provide my staff a copy of your testimony so that they can disseminate accordingly and to efficiently include into the Committee Report.
- (3) Those providing oral testimony will first be recognized by the Chair before speaking and begin by stating your name, organization, and position (if relevant) for record-keeping purposes.
- (4) Senators will be given an opportunity at the end of each panel to ask questions, (but due to the potential high volume of those testifying I respectfully ask that questions be concise to facilitate the participation of the public).
- (5) Questions and testimony shall be confined to the substance or nature of the agenda. The personal inference as to the character or the motive of any Senator, or any individual testifying, is NOT permitted.

Chairperson Sabina Flores Perez Chairperson: Currently we have not received any written testimony currently, but we are here to receive the oral testimony. So I'd like to call upon Commissioner Michelle Santos for her testimony. Good morning.

Michelle B. Santos, *Commissioner*: Good morning, Senator. My testimony is oral, and I will submit it written before the 19th.

I've known Jason Baza for over 20 years, although my work experience with him is very limited. I have sat with him in fiscal policy meetings when he represented the Director. I found him to be very professional and competent. I believe he would be an asset to our board. I know him as hardworking, focused, and competent.

He grew up with my children. He played soccer. I coached him. He has great parents. They're very supportive and caring and outstanding citizens in the community. I find Jason very respectful, humble and easy to work with. Never gave me a hard time as his coach. I think he would be a great asset to our board. Also, I think it would be a good experience for him as an upcoming government employee to know our side of the business, what we do at the Banking and Insurance Board. He would also be working with some prominent citizens in this area, our banking experts, and our insurance experts. So, I think he would learn a lot from our division and work with us on the Banking and Insurance Board. Thank you, Senator.

Chairperson Perez: Thank you Commissioner Santos for your testimony. Next on the list is Mr. Carlson, you're recognized.

Lester Carlson, *Budget Director, Bureau of Budget, Management, and Research*: Good morning, Senator Perez. It's a pleasure to be here today. In full support of the nomination of Mr. Jason Baza to sit on the banking and insurance board. For the record, my name is Lester Carlson. I'm the Director of the Bureau of Budget and Management Research. Jason works for me. Jason has over 10 years of experience beginning as a BMA I, Budget Management Analyst I. Worked his way up to a BMA IV, and now is a Budget Management Supervisor, and his progression has been well earned, well deserved.

He is certainly, as the Commissioner Bordallo has said, a man of very high integrity. Jason comes before this Committee willingly in an effort to promote public service. Jason's work ethic and ability to undertake new programs such as the American Rescue Plan, and the eligibility of ARP expenditures is a recent example of how he can get into the batter's box and hit the best curve ball thrown at him.

I rely on Jason for, as the Bounty paper towel commercial says, he's the quicker picker upper. Quite honestly, while that's a good analogy, Jason is truly much better than Bounty. I support his nomination and I'm honored that he was chosen to fill the classified government employee position on this Board. I am sure with the guidance of Commissioner Bordallo, her seasoned staff and the current board members, many of whom I know personally, Jason will be a quick learner, will serve with a high degree of integrity and assist in the mission of the Insurance and Banking Commission. Thank you very much.

Chairperson Perez: Thank you so much Mr. Carlson, for your testimony today. Now I'd like to recognize the nominee himself, Jason Baza.

Jason W. Baza, *Nominee:* Thank you, Senator. *Håfa Adai* Madam Chair, Senator Perez and to the members of the 37th Guam Legislature. Thank you for your attendance today. I'd be remiss if I didn't take the time to thank and acknowledge the Commissioner of the Guam Banking and Insurance Commission, as well as the Director of Bureau Budget and Management Research, who are here to speak in support of my nomination as the Government of Guam's classified employee representative for the Guam Banking and Insurance Commission.

My name is Jason Baza, and this is my first appointment to any Government of Guam Board. I'm a graduate of Father Duenas Memorial School Class of 2008, and went on to study at Seattle University, where I earned a bachelor's degree in Strategic Communications. I am currently a Budget and Management Analyst Supervisor for the Bureau of Budget and Management Research, and I've been with the Bureau for the last decade.

I have been blessed to be surrounded by the outstanding staff of our department throughout the years, along with our point of contacts from departments that we work with that have helped me grow into the professional that I am today. As someone who has played sports all my life, I definitely value the concept of teamwork, and I am fortunate to work with such a great team.

As a Budget Management Analyst Supervisor, I take pride in being diligent and expeditious with my daily tasks assigned to myself and the analysts under my supervision. These daily tasks include the review of personnel actions, account modifications, establishment of accounts, preparation of fiscal notes, travel authorizations, and the list goes on.

The Bureau's review of documents submissions entail accuracy and consistent verification to ensure any action being requested is within the guidelines of the Budget Act, Guam Code Annotated, and or the terms and conditions of a grant award should the account be a federal grant. Most importantly, it is a Bureau's duty to not only ensure that departments maximize the funds appropriated to them to provide essential services to the community, but to closely monitor department expenditure trends and validate that they will not exceed their authorized spending level in the fiscal year.

The duties that I perform at the Bureau provide a complimentary correlation to the duties of filling the member position of the Guam Banking and Insurance Commission, particularly in ensuring that action deemed appropriate by the Board is in accordance with the Administrative Adjudication Act. It is with great honor to accept this nomination and should it be the will of this body, I look forward to serving as a member of this board. Thank you.

Chairperson Perez: Thank you so much Jason for accepting this nomination. I think it is telling that you're able to advance in the years that you've been at BBMR from the entry level to supervisor. So, it does tell me that you are willing to learn and pick up, and this idea of complacency is not in your vocabulary. I think that's critical when we confirm any new members to a board, especially a board as important as this that holds a lot of power, and this is an important industry for Guam considering what's happening in the country these days.

We hear there are banks that are closing, and so the Board members really have to keep an eye on our industry to ensure that the practices that led to these closures are not occurring here. Have you had any opportunity To review what's going on in the states and how it could potentially impact Guam? What would be your role as a commissioner to ensure that it doesn't repeat itself here?

Jason Baza: Yes, I have had an opportunity to look into the situation in the States. In the case of SVB, what was reported is that they were doing a lot of high risk, high reward deposits within their bank and there were red flags, and they didn't heed the warning of those red flags by the regulatory agencies. Then once interest rates picked up, the value of those investments became of lesser value, which in result caused the bank to close. Then the role of how this would affect Guam is that we have representatives within the banks that control risk, and it's the job of the Board to ensure that the risk doesn't exceed any potential gain, avoid any high-risk transactions, or high risk opportunities.

Chairperson Perez: I appreciate that response. You're not even confirmed yet, but we do look for members that are critical and keep an open eye on what's going on out there and how we can better protect the industry. Do you see yourself as having any conflicts of interest?

Jason Baza: No, I do not. My only financial income is my employment with the Government of Guam.

Chairperson Perez: Would this participation on the Commission affect your role in BBMR?

Jason Baza: It should not. No, I should be able to attend every meeting. I'm a man that's able to juggle tasks with efficiency, and I'm someone that once I commit to something, I'm all in with the commitment.

Chairperson Perez: Okay, great. Because the position you serve on the board is a classified employee of the Government of Guam representative. What do you see as your contribution to this board?

Jason Baza: I see my contribution as being the Government of Guam's voice in the actions taken by the Board. As my role as a Budget and Management Analyst Supervisor, the nature of our job is to ensure that public finances are spent accordingly, and this translates very well with the role of being the classified Government of Guam member on this Board.

Chairperson Perez: Thank you, Jason. It's great to see young faces, and not only young faces, but critically minded individuals that we need to nurture in their leadership roles. So, we do appreciate your accepting this nomination. If there are no others to testify at this time, your confirmation hearing is duly heard.
