



DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA BRINGS A UNIQUE PERSPECTIVE THAT WILL CONTINUE TO AID GEDA AS WE STRIVE TO BRING THIS PASSION TO FRUITION.

THANK YOU AS ALWAYS FOR YOUR TIME, AND I RESPECTFULLY ENCOURAGE THE MEMBERS OF I MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN TO CONFIRM DR. DOREEN CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA'S REAPPOINTMENT TO THE GEDA BOARD, EXPEDITOUSLY.

CHAIRMAN QUINATA: THANK YOU MISS MEL WE'RE DEFINITELY GOING TO DO THIS EXPEDITIOUSLY AS THIS IS A REAPPOINTMENT I WILL NOW YIELD THE FLOOR TO MY COLLEAGUE SENATOR TAITAGUE IF SHE HAS ANY QUESTIONS FOR THE APPOINTMENT.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: THANK YOU MR. CHAIR AND GOOD AFTERNOON TO EVERYONE ESPECIALLY GEDA IT'S ALWAYS GOOD TO SEE YOU MEL. DR CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA I KNOW YOUR WHOLE FAMILY. IF DAVE WAS HERE YOU KNOW SITTING HERE WHICH I'M HOPING HE TRIES NEXT TIME I KNOW HE WOULD PROBABLY HAVE A LOT TO ADD TO WHY YOU'D BE THE PERFECT FIT FOR THIS POSITION. YOU KNOW YOU'VE BEEN VERY HARD WORKER I THINK I MEAN JUST LOOK AT YOUR BACKGROUND AND ALL THAT YOU'VE ACCOMPLISHED. GEDA IS VERY LUCKY TO HAVE SOMEONE LIKE YOU ON BOARD SO I APPRECIATE THAT. WE WERE HERE LAST TIME FOR DAVID JOHN'S CONFIRMATION HEARING AND IT'S STILL THE TWO OF US. THERE'S NOT THAT MANY PEOPLE HERE BUT YOU KNOW FOR ME IT'S IMPORTANT THAT IF ANYBODY WANTS TO SERVE THE PEOPLE OF GUAM, WE SHOULD BE HERE TO ASK QUESTIONS AND ENSURE THAT WE'RE CHOOSING THE RIGHT PERSON FOR THE JOB BUT MOST ESPECIALLY TO BE HERE OUT OF RESPECT FOR YOU IF YOU'RE TAKING THE TIME OUT OF YOUR TIME TO TAKING TIME OUT OF YOUR SCHEDULE TO BE A PART OF MAKING GUAM GREAT THEN THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR STEPPING UP TO THE PLATE FOR THAT. THERE WAS A QUESTION I DID ASK DAVID JOHN ON HIS CONFIRMATION HOW DID HE FEEL ABOUT BOARD MEMBER TERM LIMITS AND SO HOW DO YOU FEEL ABOUT TERM LIMITS SITTING ON THE BOARD.

DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA: I REALLY DON'T KNOW BECAUSE I DON'T REALLY SIT ON THE BOARD THAT LONG.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN ON THE BOARD?

DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA: WELL I SAT ON THE GUAM HOUSING BOARD AND THIS ONE.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: YES, GEDA.

DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA: YEAH A COUPLE OF MONTHS.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: HOW MANY.

DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA: ONLY SINCE DECEMBER.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: OKAY SO IT'S KIND OF HARD TO I MEAN IT'S NICE TO HAVE AN INSTITUTIONAL KNOWLEDGE YOU KNOW FROM OTHER INDIVIDUALS BUT WHEN YOU'RE GOING TO SERVE FOR HOW LONG IF YOU'RE CONFIRMED, WHAT IS THE TIME LENGTH.

MELANIE MENDIOLA: FOUR YEARS.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: FOUR YEARS SO TWO TERMS WOULD HAVE AN INDIVIDUAL SERVING FOR ALMOST EIGHT YEARS IN THAT CAPACITY YOU KNOW AND I'M SURE THERE'S OTHER PEOPLE WHO WANT TO WANT TO SERVE YOU KNOW ALSO ON GEDA IT'S A VERY LIVELY AND INTERESTING BOARD AND DEFINITELY A GREAT NETWORKING BOARD TO BE ON TOO AS WELL ESPECIALLY IF YOU'RE IN BUSINESS SO WELL THINK ABOUT IT YOU KNOW I KNOW IT'S NEXT TIME YOU COME UP FOR CONFIRMATION I'LL ASK YOU THE SAME QUESTION AGAIN IF I'M HERE IF I'M NOT I'M HOPING SOMEBODY ELSE WILL ASK YOU WHILE YOU'VE BEEN THERE SINCE DECEMBER I KNOW THAT WE PASSED A BILL THE SECOND ROUND OF LEAP THE LEAP PROGRAM ARE YOU FAMILIAR WITH THAT PROGRAM.

DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA: YES.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: OKAY HAS GEDA IMPLEMENTED THAT YET?

DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA: NO NOT YET BUT WE DID APPROVE LIKE THE STAND THE SOP FOR IT.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE. WELL IT'S ROUND TWO SO YOU DON'T HAVE ONE ALREADY IN PLACE. IF YOU CAN'T ANSWER MEL IT NO I'LL TAKE I'LL TAKE YOUR ANSWER IF YOU CAN.

MELANIE MENDIOLA: SURE, THE WE DID A SECOND ANOTHER A REVISED STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE BECAUSE THE FORMULA CALCULATION BECAUSE OF THE AMOUNT OF MONEY WAS DIFFERENT AND SO WE REFLECTED SOME OF THOSE CHANGES IN THE STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE SO THE CALCULATION IS DIFFERENT IN ADDITION TO THE MAXIMUM AWARDS ARE ALSO DIFFERENT AND SO GIVEN THAT WE WE UTILIZED OUR ORIGINAL SOP. WE UPDATED IT AND TOOK IT TO THE BOARD FOR PRESENTATION AND A SUBSEQUENT APPROVAL IT HAS NOT BEEN IMPLEMENTED YET, MA'AM.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: BUT IT HAS BEEN IMPROVED BY THE BOARD.

MELANIE MENDIOLA: YES.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: OKAY IT HASN'T BEEN IMPLEMENTED WHY IS THAT HASN'T IT.

MELANIE MENDIOLA: THE ORIGINAL I BELIEVE THE ORIGINAL TRIGGER DATE FOR IT WAS WAS SUPPOSED TO BE WE WERE HOPING FOR MAY FOR A LAUNCH AND THEN OF COURSE THE TYPHOON HAPPENED AND THEN AT THE TIME THE FEEDBACK THAT WE RECEIVED FROM

SENATOR TAITAGUE: IT'S EXCESS FY 23 EXCESS REVENUE.

MELANIE MENDIOLA: YES THAT'S CORRECT.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: SO WE WON'T KNOW THAT UNTIL NEXT YEAR.

MELANIE MENDIOLA: THAT'S CORRECT AND SO THERE'S A MINOR THERE'S A TECHNICALITY ASPECT OF IT BUT IN ADDITION TO JUST A CASH FLOW ASSESSMENT THAT WE WERE THE PRIORITY OF COURSE WAS MAWAR RECOVERY AND RELIEF AND THEN TO DO AN ASSESSMENT OF EXCESS. AS YOU POINTED OUT MA'AM.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: OKAY, THANK YOU, THANK YOU MEL FOR THAT DR CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA SINCE YOU'VE BEEN SERVING IN DECEMBER WHAT AREAS HAVE YOU CONTRIBUTED IS IT LIKE BROKEN UP IN CERTAIN SUBJECT MATTERS ARE YOU WORKING ON OR JUST YOU LISTEN TO EVERYTHING OR WHAT IS YOUR INTEREST IN IN GEDA WHAT'S THE ONE PART THAT YOU CAN YOU CAN CONTRIBUTE TO.

DR. CRISOSOTOMO-MUÑA: TINA'S COMMITTEE BONDS.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: BONDS.

DR. SENATOR TAITAGUE: FOR TAXES AND THAT WAS THAT KIND OF LEADS ME INTO MY NEXT QUESTION DO YOU FEEL YOU HAVE A CONFLICT OF INTEREST IN ANY WAY AND IF YOU DO SOMETHING COMES UP THAT DEALS WITH YOU KNOW TAXES OR SOME A INDIVIDUAL WHO'S UP FOR SOME FUNDING FROM GEDA THAT COULD BE A CLIMATE OR A CLIENT OR POTENTIAL CLIENT.

DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA: NO.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: READY TO RECUSE YOURSELF.

DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA: YES I AM BUT I DON'T HAVE ANY BUSINESS AT THIS TIME.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: YOU DON'T HAVE ANY BUSINESS.

DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA: AT THIS TIME YEAH WE ARE I DON'T HAVE.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: OKAY WELL OTHER THAN THAT I WISH YOU THE VERY YOU KNOW VERY MUCH GREAT LUCK FOR YOU TO YOU KNOW MOVE FORWARD IN THIS CAPACITY BUT AND YOU OF COURSE HAVE APPROVAL FROM THE FAMILY TO SIT ON THIS BOARD RIGHT I SEE YOUR HUSBANDS HERE TO PROVIDE THAT SUPPORT. DO WE GOT A THUMBS UP MR MUÑA AND THE DAUGHTER RIGHT.

DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA: YES, GRANDDAUGHTER.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: YES A LOT OF TIMES YOU'RE TAKEN AWAY FROM YOUR FAMILY YOU KNOW WHEN YOU HAVE THESE BOARD MEETINGS OR THE A LOT OF STUDY TIME IS AT HOME TOO AS WELL SO TO HAVE THE SUPPORTIVE FAMILY IS SO IMPORTANT SO THAT YOU CAN SUCCEED IN WHAT YOU'RE DOING SO I WISH YOU AGAIN THE VERY BEST AND MY DOOR IS ALWAYS OPEN SO IF I COULD BE OF ANY HELP ASSISTANCE TO YOU PLEASE DON'T HESITATE TO ASK.

DR. CRISOSTOMO-MUÑA: THANK YOU.

SENATOR TAITAGUE: THANK YOU SO MUCH THANK YOU MEL FOR BEING HERE AND THE GEDA TEAM IT'S GOOD TO SEE YOU GUYS.
