

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:02 a.m.

#### Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Buenas and Hafa adai everyone. Good morning and welcome to the Guam Congress building.

The public hearing by the Committee on Maritime and Air Transportation, Parks, Tourism, Higher Education, and the Advancement of Women, Youth, and Senior Citizens is hereby called to order. Today is Friday, September 8, 2023 and the time now is 9:02 a.m.

For the record and in accordance with the Open Government Law, notices for this hearing were sent on August 30th and again on September 1st. In addition, the hearing was noticed on the Guam legislature website and the public notice website.

Joining me here this morning, Senator Joanne Brown and Senator Tom Fisher, si Yu'os ma'ase' colleagues for being here this morning.

Before we proceed with the discussion I'd like to first provide some general rules of conduct for those in attendance. The conduct of this hearing shall be as follows. Written testimony shall be submitted to the committee - please provide the legislative staff with your written testimony for photocopying.

Testimony may be read and lengthy testimony should be summarized to about five minutes. Those testifying will be allowed to present written or oral testimony. Once you are done please remain in the room for questions or additional testimony as may be desired by members of the committee.

Testimony shall be confined to the nature of the agenda - the agenda is the appointment of Mr. Jesse G. Garcia to serve as a member of the Guam International Airport Authority Board of Directors.

The Chair will invite individuals who have signed up to testify to begin. Before speaking, individuals testifying shall first be recognized, and state your name and position for the record. The order of questioning will begin with the panel of senators who shall complete their lines of questioning on this agenda item.

Personal inference as to the character or motive of any Senator or any individual testifying is not permitted. Any violations of this general rule of conduct will result in removal from the public hearing room. Individuals who fail to maintain proper form may be restricted from providing oral testimony and/ or may be asked to leave or be escorted and removed from the room. Proper form and decorum shall be practiced by all present in the public hearing room.

The A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Guam was created by Public Law 13-57 as an autonomous agency of the government of Guam, to own, maintain, and operate and develop airport facilities and properties. GIAA took over operations from the Department of Commerce in 1976 and since then has been the island's only commercial airport supporting domestic and international air travel for passengers and cargo.

GIAA, led by its board of directors and management, strives to ensure the safety and security of the traveling public and is dedicated to maintaining a superior and reliable level of airport services for our Island residents and tourists, and is committed to supporting the development of air linkages and facilities which are integral parts of the island's current and future economic growth.

At this time I'd like to invite our Board of Directors, Mr. Brian Bamba, followed by our Executive Manager, former Senator John Quinata, to provide their testimony before our nominee, Mr. Garcia. Mr. Bamba.

#### Mr. Brian Bamba, Chairman, GIAA Board of Directors:

Good morning and thank you Senator Shelton, Madam Legislative Secretary, and Honorable members of the Committee on Air Transportation. I proudly submit testimony today in full support of the reappointment of Mr. Jesse G. Garcia to the Board of Directors of the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Guam. # Mr. John Quinata, Executive Manager, A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam:

Good morning Honorable Senators of the 37th Guam Legislature - Senator Brown, Senator Fisher, and, of course, our oversight chair, Senator Amanda Shelton. Buenas and Hafa adai Madam Legislative Secretary and Honorable members of the Committee on Air Transportation.

I am proud to appear and testify before you today in full support of the reappointment of Mr. Jesse G. Garcia to the Board of Directors of the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Guam.

Jesse Garcia first joined the board in February of 2022 - filling an unexpired term of former Director Zenon Belanger. Since that time, Director Garcia has contributed greatly to the Board and exhibited leadership in the Board's Capital Improvement Projects subcommittee. With his expansive career in the government and private sector, Jess Garcia brings with him an acute awareness of government planning, capital improvement projects, procurement procedures, safety, and law enforcement experiences and has worked intimately with the federal regulatory agencies such as the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

We have Mrs. Tina Garcia. We have Mr. Raymond Mantanona, Fire Chief from the airport. Mr. Anthony Quidachay from the airport. Ms. Marlene Pinaula from the airport. And, the Vice Chair of the Board as well, Mr. "Bic" Sobti. Welcome everyone. Thank you for being here.

# Jesse G. Garcia, Appointee:

Good morning Chairperson Senator Amanda Shelton and members of the committee.

It is my honor to appear before you this morning as a nominee for a full three-year term on the GIAA Board of Directors. As you know I was appointed and confirmed to fill an unplanned board vacancy that occurred in 2022.

Over the past year I have learned a great deal about the aviation industry generally and in particular, the organizational and operational dynamics of our airport. The A.B. Won Pat airport is more than a key transportation hub, it is a vital economic link to the businesses and industries both locally and for the greater Micronesia region. Our airport brings together goods and people, and benefits to Guam, our neighbors close by and throughout Asia. It plays a critical role in the security of our island and in supporting the role of defense of our nation. During the past year I've become privy to the short-term, immediate, and long-term goals of the airport including planned improvements to the main terminal building and adjacent properties.

It became very clear in my tenure that there is a commitment on the part of both the airport board and the management team to work together to grow GIAA with our island for the benefit of the people. It is home to warehousing facilities, retail shops and restaurants. It interacts and answers to agencies both local and federal. It is home to companies both domestic and foreign, provides direct employment to hundreds of people in positions which are critical to the airport operations and broader tourism industry, and remains a source of indirect employment for hundreds more. All of this in support of its core mission which is of course is the safe efficient movement of passengers and cargo on dozens of arriving and departing flights 24/7, 365 days a year.

I believe good stewardship is about providing the way and means of management to keep the airport running at optimal performance while developing visionary policies in the initiatives for its continued success in the future.

It has been my privilege to serve on the GIAA Board of Directors this past year. It would be my honor to do so for another 3 years. Thank you and *Si Yu'os ma'ase'*.

#### Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Si Yu'os ma'ase' Mr. Garcia.

We'll begin with questions from the Senators here today, Senator Fisher. Before you begin, I'd also like to recognize Senator Taitague for joining us. Thank you very much.

#### **Senator Thomas Fisher:**

Thank you very much Madam Chair. I'm just, I was looking at your resume sir. It's very impressive. I really don't have any questions. I was just seeing some 31 years of government service - is that correct? And, it is very impressive. Department of Public Works. You've been a construction manager on many different projects in your career which, of course, is necessary at the airport so I don't really have any questions. I just wanted to highlight that you seem evidently qualified for the position. Thank you sir.

#### Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Thank you very much Senator Fisher.

Senator Brown.

#### Senator Joanne Brown:

I think Mr. Garcia is doing very well to get by that well with Senator Fisher. You know, I have to tell you a story because I've known Jesse Garcia for many years and I've also known his wife for many years and I didn't know they were married to each other. I thought wow these two good people at some point found each other because of course I've had the opportunity to work with your mom when I first became Senator 28 years ago and she worked at my office together for several years and I certainly appreciate looking back at those days.

Those early days when I was here and the only time I found out the two of you were married was I went to a graduation invitation for your daughter and then I realized they were in the same house and so that's how I found out that Tina and Jesse Garcia were married to each other. It's just one of those interesting moments but I don't have any questions for you. I see in your background having worked at Johnson Control you referenced that you were involved in energy efficiency up at the Guam Airport Authority as part of your duties there and a number of things I think. The fact that you were rehired back in the private sector even though you were pulled back for a short time to DPW, obviously your skill sets are well valued by Black Construction - to bring you back to work with them again, but what do you see in moving forward in your continued role on the board at the Guam

Airport Authority? What would you like to see expand further or contribute in terms of your efforts to improve the operations and efficiency of the airport?

# Jesse G. Garcia, Appointee:

Basically the operations of the airport whatever happens up at the airport. I have a background in most of the operations at the airport, to the construction, to security. I feel I bring a lot of my knowledge to the airport, to help out with the operations.

#### **Senator Joanne Brown:**

Do you see something more you'd like to see improved because obviously with your background and construction, and we know that the airport just recently completed a major project up there in their expansion. What would you like to see that you feel you're going to be able to contribute and add on to the board and certainly the enhancement and improvement of the airport authority?

# Jesse G. Garcia, Appointee:

There's still a lot of things that the airport needs to be improved and we're working on it with our other members and consultants that have been giving us information. We take it and analyze the operations and to make sure it'll work.

#### **Senator Joanne Brown:**

And, in your time that you've been there at the airport authority, how would you assess the airport's performance so far?

# Jesse G. Garcia, Appointee:

There's still some challenges that we're working on and hopefully can get better.

#### **Senator Joanne Brown:**

Well I appreciate it. I know Mr. Garcia this is not the forum you care for very much. This is not your element but in your element, I mean, we've been able to see all the things you can do. I mean you're definitely, when they say you're a can-do person, I think a lot of people that know you would say that sums up Jesse Garcia because you are very resourceful. I mean, you can make things happen in the work that you do. And, as I mentioned, I think the fact that Black Construction pulled you back is much to their benefit because the skill sets that you have and the experience that you have is - not too many people walking around that have your capability. So, you certainly

have our continued support to serve on the airport board and appreciate your interest in wanting to continue your public service. Thank you. Thank you very much. Thank you Madam Chair.

#### Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Thank you very much Senator Brown.

Senator Taitague.

#### **Senator Telo Taitague:**

Thank you Madam Chair and good morning to my colleagues and especially to those who are here today to testify. *Hafa adai*, Tina. This goes, Tina, is so good to see you. You know and you're supporting, that you're allowing him to serve another three or well three years at least because just seeing without the you know the support of your family, I question it because it takes away time from the home when you serve on the board not just going to the meetings but outside of the meetings when you do the research. When you look at the documents in front of you and determine what's in the best interest of the airport. So, I appreciate that. Jesse, you are serving now from someone who left the airport or this is your second term?

# Jesse G. Garcia, Appointee:

Zenon Belanger resigned from the board and as a director in 2022 and then I came in and came in for confirmation.

#### **Senator Telo Taitague:**

How long ago was that?

#### Jesse G. Garcia, Appointee:

It's about a little over a year and a half.

#### **Senator Telo Taitague:**

So, you've been there about a year and a half now right? So, you've had enough time to try and make a difference then right?

Okay, have you ever had a conflict of interest where you had to recuse yourself?

#### Jesse G. Garcia, Appointee:

Yes, there have been a couple times yes. I recused myself.

#### Senator Telo Taitague:

Then you have recused so it's good to know with good reason okay. The other one is, have you been attending all the board meetings?

# Jesse G. Garcia, Appointee:

Yes, I haven't missed the board meeting only when I'm off-island. If I'm on-island I attend.

#### **Senator Telo Taitague:**

But, how many times have you missed a board meeting?

### Jesse G. Garcia, Appointee:

Maybe about two times.

#### **Senator Telo Taitague:**

This wasn't going to be easy, you know that? But I will tell you one thing: DPW really lost a good man. I mean it. All the work that you've done there you've even been supervisor of the year at DPW at one point, so I'm sure that they're kicking themselves not giving you whatever you wanted to stay there. But the port has gained someone with a lot of wealth of knowledge, especially considering what happened in this typhoon with all the flooding that was going on at the hospital I mean... that too. That's on my mind but at the airport, to provide some, you know, ideas and suggestions how to rectify this issue because we're anticipating.

There might be another typhoon coming down the line because of what FEMA mentioned to us earlier so that's really good. But, there's something I'm hoping Jesse that you would also look into and try and beef up at the airport and that is cyber security. You know I brought this up before and the importance of it. I mean, this is a direction now that is taking on the world and at a faster pace and putting us all in harm's way. It's holding us hostage, so I hope that you look into that area because we're finding out other, the hospital, other agencies, the hospital, GCC, UOG, Docomo - they've all been hacked. So, the last thing we need is to have any kind of accident at the hospital by being hacked or you know in someone else's hands other than the airport. So, I hope that you really look into that and move in that direction of ensuring the security of the airport cyberly okay? Okay, other than that I'm gonna hold you to it and you have my support.

#### Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Thank you Senator Taitague.

I'd like to also welcome Senator Quinata. Do you have any questions for Mr. Garcia?

# Senator Roy A. B. Quinata:

Good morning. Did you just get a haircut because you're coming here today? No, you have my full support. I know you're a tried and true individual. You're still the one no matter what disaster, you've always been at the front lines and in any, in any respect even in the private sector. You've always been a reliable person and I don't think there's anything to question about your career. Your career is older than me, is as old as me, 31. I'm only 26. So, I don't think I should be questioning anyone that has that kind of experience and that kind of expertise. So, with that being said Mr. Garcia, I wish you all the best and if my office needs to help you in any way, you know where to find me and you know how to call me.

#### Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton

Thank you very much Senator Quinata. And, thank you to Mr. Garcia for your continued willingness to serve in this capacity and for your many years of government service. We understand you are a true asset to this board and so we look forward to moving your nomination quickly - so that you can continue serving. Si Yu'os ma'ase'.
