





The public hearing was Called-to-Order at **<u>2:05 PM</u>**.

Senator Chris Barnett, Chairman – Committee on Education, Public Safety and the Arts: Buenas and Håfa adai, good afternoon. This public hearing conducted by the Committee on Education, Public Safety and the Arts is called to order at 2:05 Chamorro

Standard Time. Notice of the hearing was disseminated to all local media outlets on May 15th, 2024 with the second notice provided on May 20th, 2024. Notice of the hearing was also made known on the Guam Legislature's website and the Government of Guam Public Notices Portal. This afternoon, the Committee will hear testimony on the following agenda items. The reappointment of Lulene C. San Augustin as a member, guidance counselor of the Guam Commission for Educator Certification.

We'll also hear testimony on Bill No. 253 -37 (COR), introduced by Senator Joe S. San Augustin, which is an act to amend §3102.3 of Chapter 3, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated relative to the composition and terms of office for board members of the Guam Board of Education. We'll also hear testimony on Bill No. 276-37 (LS), which I introduced along with co-sponsors, Senator Sabina Perez and Joanne Brown, which is an act to add a new paragraph to §3103 of Chapter three, Title 17 Guam Code annotated relative to requiring all reports of the Superintendent of Education to the Guam Education Board be posted on the Guam Department of Education's website. And lastly, we'll hear testimony on Bill No. 282-37 (LS), introduced by Senator Dwayne San Nicolas, which is an act to add and amend § 8102(v), 8102 (bb), 8104(b) of Article 1, Chapter 8, Title 5A Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations relative to removing the Praxis Core Mathematics requirement from the Guam Educator Certification Requirement.

I'd like to welcome my colleagues joining us today Senator Joe San Augustin and Senator Dwayne San Nicolas. And I am Senator Chris Barnett. Before we begin, I'd like to go over general rules of conduct. Individuals testifying shall first be recognized by the chair before speaking, and shall state their name for record keeping purposes. Questions and testimony shall be confined to the substance or nature of the agenda. Personal inference as to the character or motive of any senator or individual testifying is not permitted. The chairperson of the committee may order the removal from a hearing any member of I Liheslaturan Guahan who fails to observe proper decorum pursuant to the 37th Guam Legislature's standing rules. Any violation of this general rule of conduct will result in removal from the hearing by the host.

We'll now proceed with hearing testimony on the reappointment of Miss Lulene C. San Agustin as a member of the Guam Commission for Educator Certification. We'll hear from those who are here to present testimony on behalf of the nominee before we hear from Miss and Augustine and signed up to provide a testimony. We have Ms. Maria Gutierrez. Good afternoon, Ms. Gutierrez.

Maria Gutierrez, Vice Chair – Guam Education Board: Good afternoon, Mr. Chair, Senator San Agustin, and Senator Dwayne. My name is Maria T. Gutierrez. I'm a resident of Tamuning and a voting from the municipality of Tamuning. I'm here this afternoon to testify in support of the reappointment of Ms. Lulene Concepcion San Agustin. I have known the Lulene for many years, not only as a counselor, but we have a relation from the Mendiola blood and I'm very confident that her representation on the Guam Educators Commission is very important, especially that the Department of Education teachers are the only one that have to go to the Certification Commission as under the 14 points, we need certified teachers, number one of that 14 points. So, I know that she would do good

because she's not only new to DOE, she's been there. And Lulene is one of those counselors that when we received the NASVI award for early childhood on the mental health, she was one of those that developed a policy for the early childhood mental health to provide to the students. And so it is policy 382. So, there's nothing else I can say. I know her not only as a counselor, but as a family member, so I think, please confirm her at your earliest session.

Chairman Barnett: Thank you. Mrs. Gutierrez. Is there anyone else who wishes to provide testimony on the nomination of Lulene C. San Agustin? If not, then we'll hear from the nominee. Buenas and good afternoon Mrs. San Agustin.

Ms. Lulene C. San Agustin, Nominee: Håfa Adai. Thank you Mrs. Gutierrez. Håfa Adai Senator Barnett, Senator San Nicolas, and Senator San Agustin. I guess, if you could just kind of maybe describe your service under the commission and some of the things you look forward to doing if you're reappointed for a second term.

Ms. San Agustin: Okay, so since I've been on the commission for a few months, we have worked on the classes in lieu for the praxis test. If they were taking the practice test if they don't make it within five points, we have that in place. I've also reviewed some extended applicants for their certification and have a few of those approved. That's where that's what I've done in the few months that I've been with the with the commission and the working with the praxis that was already in motion when I got in.

Chairman Barnett: What are some of the challenges, if any, that you've seen you know, with teachers trying to become certified and taking the praxis exam?

Ms. San Agustin: As of right, I, I haven't come in, we've had a few that have challenges for certification, but I don't have, there wasn't many for the praxis, and if it was for the praxis, I don't have the exact what subject it was in. Yeah.

Chairman Barnett: Can you kind of explain how important you feel having the perspective of a guidance counselor on the commission is?

Ms. San Agustin: Having a school counselor on the commission because we do have to get certified by the commission having me, having, that I'm in the classroom, I mean, in the school, at the school level, and I'm able to understand what is needed to be a good counselor and a productive counselor, I think I can great, give great input and what's the importance of needing for the certification.

Chairman Barnett: As a guidance counselor, are you aware of some of the challenges and concerns that guidance counselors have you know, in the Guam Department of Education?

Ms. San Agustin: I do. I do. Yes.

Chairman Barnett: Would you mind sharing some of those concerns?

Ms. San Agustin: Okay, so, there's within the counseling division we have counselors who look at ways of use the ASCA. We use our ASCA formats and you know, to go we follow through with the ASCA do's and don'ts and that. And so we do have some counselors who are really trying to push for it you know, and I understand that, but I also understand that, you know, In the school system being where we're at and we are short of a lot of supports

in terms of, you know, for our students our ability to help the entire school however which way we can is very crucial.

Chairman Barnett: And how would you describe the status of the certification of guidance counselors? Are we looking at a backlog or are we moving along you know, at an adequate pace?

Ms. San Agustin: I don't see any backlog with the certification of counselors.

Chairman Barnett: Okay. Thank you, ma'am. I'd like to recognize my colleague, Senator Telo Taitague. Thank you for joining us. And I'd like to also defer to Senator Joe San Agustin for any questions for the nominee.

Senator Joe S. San Agustin, Member - Committee on Education, Public Safety, and the Arts: Thank you. Thank you, Mr. Chair. Well, you know, the nice thing about the nominee is we have the same last name. Thank you. And we're, and you're from, you're a Concepcion, so you're from Yigo. Pretty much recognize that. You know, you have an edge. You know, I looked at your background and, gosh, I'm really great support for. So, SBA, law, you work for your honor Anita Sokola, you're a bailiff, and you're a school counselor. You know, great resume. You got my full support. Thank you. Ms. San Agustin.

Ms. San Agustin: I appreciate that.

Senator San Agustin: Great last name, and great middle name, you know, but you know, technically when I look at your resume it carries its own weight, regardless of who, what's your last name. It speaks for itself. It's just, it just makes me feel good because your last name's the same as mine is, so it works that way. And, you know, it's not being biased, but your resume says a lot. And the people want need to recognize that it's what you've accomplished and where you're heading and you have foresight. You're looking outside the box and you're moving forward with this. And I will, I fully support your nomination. Thank you, Ms. San Agustin.

Ms. San Agustin: Thank you, Mr. San Agustin.

Chairman Barnett: Thank you, Senator San Agustin. Senator San Nicolas?

Senator Dwayne San Nicolas: Counselors rock.

Ms. San Agustin: Thank you.

Senator San Nicolas: I'm a former school counselor myself. You know, the chairman had asked you some questions about the praxis. Have you had any difficulty yourself when you took the praxis test?

Ms. San Agustin: I did. I did take the praxis twice. Yes.

Senator San Nicolas: So, are you familiar with the company or the nonprofit organization that, that administers the praxis?

Ms. San Agustin: ETS? Yes. Yes. I'm not entirely familiar with the details, but yes.

Senator San Nicolas: Have you read any, anything lately about the current situations across the nation about the shortages of teachers and some states actually offering alternatives to the praxis.

Ms. San Agustin: I've heard of alternatives. Yes.

Senator San Nicolas: Does the commission on education, the certification board does do they are there currently alternatives?

Ms. San Agustin: We currently have one in place.

Senator San Nicolas: And what is that, ma'am? Could you describe that for me?

Ms. San Agustin: We have the, I don't have the exact SOP on it, but we do have if an aspiring teacher takes the practice core and fails within five points they are able to look for a class in lieu of the praxis and if it's approved by the certification board which we have very well qualified commissioners on it that approve it they can go ahead and take the praxis, I mean, the classes in lieu of the, in lieu of the, yes, correct.

Senator San Nicolas: Perfect. Go ahead. I don't mean to interrupt you.

Ms. San Agustin: And I have Dr. Michelle Santos, who's from the commission as well, if I'm

Senator San Nicolas: Does it cost anything to take those classes? Yes, it does. How much are those?

Ms. San Agustin: Oh! To take The alternative method?

Senator San Nicolas: Yes.

Ms. San Agustin: I believe it does.

Senator San Nicolas: Yes. But How much is that?

Ms. San Agustin: I don't have that with me.

Senator San Nicolas: So, once you pass that class you can get a certification. Is that correct?

Ms. San Agustin: Yes. Yeah. Yes.

Senator San Agustin: Nope, Nope. See somebody was shaking her head in the background. When we get to that bill, we'll probably discuss it more, but I just wanted to try to, you know, highlight, I guess, your knowledge about the current situation with I know we don't have any issues with school counselors, stuff like that. You know, but I see you have some law enforcement background as a bailiff, right?

Ms. San Agustin: Correct.

Senator San Agustin: I was a law enforcement officer. You got two check marks there and you have my support for your appointment.

Ms. San Agustin: I appreciate it. Thank you.

Senator San Nicolas: Thank you. Nothing further, Mr. Chair.

Chairman Barnett: Thank you, Senator San Nicolas, Senator Taitague.

Senator Telo T. Taitague, Member: Thank you, Mr. Chair. And good afternoon to my colleagues, most especially to the appointee. I was listening actually when you were doing your testimony and I heard part of Mrs. Gutierrez's testimony as well. And yeah, I too am very amazed with all the background that you have. This is very impressive and I'm just very grateful that you want to continue in this position. This is a reappointment, correct?

Ms. San Agustin: Correct.

Senator Taitague: Okay, but you would like to continue to do this because this is not one of those, you know, glamorous, you know, boards that you can get on and do. I mean, some people don't even know it exists, but you know, it's obvious that sitting in this position, you do it for the love of your community and to ensure that what you're doing is done correctly. I just really in awe of you and thank you for doing that. I do have one question though with regards to your responsibilities that you have and is this, is the meetings done at the University of Guam or is it done at DOE?

Ms. San Agustin: University of Guam, school of education.

Senator Taitague: Okay. So it's all located there in that area.

Ms. San Agustin: The ones that I've gone to, yes.

Senator Taitague: And do you have enough for quorum there right now? Do you have quorum?

Ms. San Agustin: Oh, we do. We do and we actually, we do have one, and we're still waiting for a teacher, there's a teacher vacancy, which I know that it's in the process.

Senator Taitague: Okay, but you're still able to do what you're tasked to do, sitting on this board, okay?

Ms. San Agustin: Correct.

Senator Taitague: So, you're just looking for one more, you know, to add on, and, okay, what is the one thing that you wish you could change? You know, when it comes to your position and overseeing this board, if you had an option to make one change to better the board's ability

Ms. San Agustin: I don't have anything that I could would want to change at this time that I know of. You know, like I said, I've been there just a few months. Yeah. So, as of right now I am okay with everything that's been going on.

Senator Taitague: Do you have a website?

Ms. San Agustin: We do have a website. Yes.

Senator Taitague: Have you had an opportunity to review the website lately?

Ms. San Agustin: Yes, I have. Yes.

Senator Taitague: And is it up and every, all the information is provided there in a timely manner and the open government law, it's put on your meetings and

Ms. San Agustin: As a matter of fact, I was just on it a few days ago and yes everything that I know is that should be there is there.

Senator Taitague: Hey, that's very good. So you've you checked all my boxes too as well. So I really appreciate it again. And of course, my office is always open. If there's anything I can be of assistance to you, because obviously, you know, giving yourself and the time away from your family to sit on this board is very commendable. And I thank you so much for that. And good luck to you.

Ms. San Agustin: Thank you. I Appreciate it.

Chairman Barnett: Si Yu'os ma'åse, Senator Taitague. Good afternoon, Senator Quinata.

Senator Roy A.B. Quinata: Thank you, Mr. Chair. Full disclosure we're actually related, but definitely have my support for your nomination. I just wanted to thank you for your service. Continue to keep up the good work. And my office stands ready to support you guys if anything is needed, okay?

Ms. San Agustin: Thank you, Senator.

Senator Quinata: Take care.

Ms. San Agustin: Thank you.

Chairman Barnett: Thank you, Senator Quinata. And Lulene, I guess that's it Pancit. Yeah, too easy. Easy money. I got kids in Yigo, so there you go. So, the circle's complete. So, Si Yu'os ma'åse. The committee will continue to accept testimony on the nomination of Mrs. Lulene C.
