HE EARNED AN ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN POLITICAL SCIENCE AND A BACHELOR OF ARTS IN BUSINESS AND PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM IN 1979 AND AS A MAN OF SERVICE SENATOR TERLAJE IS A VIETNAM WAR VETERAN HAVING SERVED THE UNITED STATES ARMY AS A FIRST SERGEANT RETIRING AFTER 20 YEARS HE WAS RECOGNIZED WITH THE SOLDIER OF THE YEAR AWARD DURING HIS SERVICE HIS CAREER CONTINUED AT THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR 18 YEARS WHERE HE ALSO WAS WAS THE LEAD OF THE NARCOTICS DIVISION AND GRADUATED FROM THE DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION DRUG ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY AND SENATOR TERLAJE COMMUNITY SERVICE INCLUDES HIS ROLE AS DIRECTOR OF CIVIL DEFENSE UNDER GOVERNOR JOSEPH F ADA WHERE HE LED RECOVERY EFFORTS FOLLOWING SUPER TYPHOON PAMELA AND AS A RESULT OF HIS INCREDIBLE EFFORTS HE WAS NAMED VICE PRESIDENT OF THE NATIONAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION PACIFIC REGION AND SENATOR TERLAJE DEVOTION FOR HELPING IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THE PEOPLE OF GUAM ENCOMPASSES HIS SERVICE AS A PUBLIC SERVANT IN 1998 SENATOR TERLAJE RAN FOR LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF GUAM WITH SENATOR ANGEL SANTOS THE GUBERNATORIAL HOPEFULS RAN A CAMPAIGN FOSTERED WITH THE CHAMORRO CULTURE AND A SPIRIT IN MIND AND COIN THEIR SLOGAN HITA WITH THE CHAMORRO INCLUSIVE FORM OF WE AND THE ACRONYM MEANING HONESTY INTEGRITY TRUST AND ACCOUNTABILITY AND SENATOR TERLAJE DID NOT SUCCEED IN THE GUBERNATORIAL RACE HE WAS ELECTED MAYOR OF YONA IN 2000 AND SERVED IN THAT ROLE FOR 12 YEARS HE ALSO SERVED AS PRESIDENT OF THE MAYOR'S COUNCIL OF GUAM AND PRESIDENT THE ASSOCIATION OF MARIANAS ISLAND MAYORS AND SENATOR TERLAJE GREW POPULAR AS AN INCREDIBLE PUBLIC OFFICIAL AS A RESULT OF HIS VILLAGE TRUST AND CONFIDENCE BUT HIS LOVE FOR GUAM GREW EVEN MORE IN 2018 SENATOR TERLAJE WAS ELECTED TO SERVE AS A MEMBER OF *I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN* THE 35<sup>TH</sup> GUAM LEGISLATURE AND CONTINUED TO SERVE IN *I MINA'TRENTAI SAIS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN* THAT'S THE 36<sup>TH</sup> GUAM LEGISLATURE HIS ROLE AS A SENATOR INCLUDE THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SAFETY EMERGENCY RESPONSE THE MAYOR'S COUNCIL OF GUAM MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS AND MASS TRANSIT HE WAS KNOWN FOR HIS CANDOR AND HIS THOUGHT BELIEFS OF HITA APPROACH ON POLICY WHILE SPEAKING THE NATIVE LANGUAGE OF GUAM CHAMORRO AND SENATOR TERLAJE UNWAVERING COMMITMENT TO BUILDING A BETTER GUAM WILL CONTINUE TO BENEFIT OUR PEOPLE FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS GUAM HISTORY WILL HONOR AND REMEMBER

**CHRIS CARRILLO:** GOOD AFTERNOON FIRST OF ALL I'D LIKE TO OFFER MY DEEPEST CONSO CONDOLENCES TO THE FAMILY AND THANK THEM ALL FOR BESTOWING THIS HONOR UPON ME TO HONOR OUR GREAT STATESMAN SENATOR PEDO TERLAJE OUR *SAINA* AND OUR LEADER SENATOR PEDO WAS A FAMILY AND BY THIS I MEAN NOTHING MEANT MORE TO HIM THAN MAKING GUAM A BETTER PLACE AND HIS FAMILY HE GAVE IT ALL OF HIS HEART HE GAVE FREELY HIS WISDOM HIS LOYALTY AND HIS SENSE OF SERVICE HIS WHOLE FAMILY ENCOMPASSES THIS TREATS OTHERS WITH THE SAME SENSE OF SERVICE IF YOU'VE EVER BEEN TO A TERLAJE FAMILY GATHERING YOU KNOW WHAT I MEAN AS I REFLECT ON SENATOR PEDO AND WHAT MADE HIM SO SPECIAL IT'S HARD TO SUM UP HIS LIFE'S WORK AND IT'S DIFFICULT TO DO HIM JUSTICE IN JUST A FEW SENTENCES AS STATED BEFORE PEDO WHO WAS A COMBAT VETERAN A POLICE OFFICER A HUSBAND A BROTHER GRANDFATHER GREAT-GRANDFATHER HE WAS A MAYOR FOR THREE TERMS THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL DEFENSE THAT LED US THROUGH TYPHOON PAMELA IN HIS LAST CHAPTER OF LIFE HE DECIDED TO BECOME A SENATOR WHICH IS WHERE I LEARNED SO MUCH AND I LEARNED SO MUCH ABOUT HIM PEDO'S NOT JUST A TYPICAL EVERYDAY SENATOR LIKE ALL THE OTHERS HE CAME HE RAN FOR SENATOR WITH A MINDSET OF IMPROVING THINGS ON GUAM THE ROLE HE SPECIFICALLY WANTED TO PLAY WAS TO IMPROVE PAY INCREASE MORALE AND RETENTION WITHIN OUR PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCIES IN OUR FIRST POLICY MEETING TOGETHER HE SAT WITH ME AND SAID WE'RE GOING TO FIX THE RETIREMENT PLAN AND I SAID WHAT DO YOU MEAN FIX IT HE SAID WE'RE GOING TO FIX IT LAW ENFORCEMENT SPENDS TOO MUCH TIME ON THE JOB AND THEY DON'T HAVE ENOUGH TIME WITH THEIR FAMILIES THEY HAVE TOO MUCH STRESS SO WE NEED TO FIX IT I ASKED HIM WHAT DID YOU MEAN AGAIN HE SAID I DON'T KNOW WE'RE GOING TO FIGURE IT OUT ANYWAY THAT WAS JUST HIM RIGHT I MEAN HE'S THE KIND OF GUY HE DECIDED TO DO SOMETHING HE WAS GONNA DO IT AND THAT'S THE KIND OF PERSON HE WAS AS A GREAT AMERICAN PRESIDENT JOHN F KENNEDY ONCE WROTE EVERY ACCOMPLISHMENT BEGINS WITH A DECISION TO TRY PEDO WAS THE EMBODIMENT OF THIS HIS DRIVE AND FOCUS ON THE SPECIFIC LEGISLATION IS HOW WE'RE ABLE TO ACHIEVE THIS MANY COLLEAGUES HAD THEIR DOUBTS THEY HAD QUESTIONS WE HAD DETRACTORS BUT HIS DECISION TO TRY WAS ULTIMATELY THE DRIVING FORCE TOWARDS PASSING THIS LEGISLATION HE'S A HUGE ADVOCATE FOR THE CULTURAL FOR CULTURAL PRESERVATION OFTEN ADDRESSED THE BODY IN HIS NATIVE LANGUAGE OF CHAMORRO DELIGHTED MANY OF OUR COLLEAGUES DELIGHTED MANY OF OUR *MAN'ÁMKO'* OFTEN OUR OFFICE CALLS WE'RE INUNDATED WITH PEOPLE JUST THANKING HIM FOR SPEAKING CHAMORRO ON THE SESSION FLOOR SOMETHING THAT'S NOT HAPPENING TOO MUCH NOWADAYS HE WAS A FIGHTER FOR THE RIGHTS OF PEOPLE WHEN THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM EMPLOYEES WERE FORCED INTO A SINGLE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER WITHOUT CHOICE HE WENT TO BAT WROTE A BILL FOR THEM TO HAVE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA TRENTAI SIETIE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

**WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jose "Pedro" Toves Terlaje was born in Yo'ña, Guam, to Jesus Castro Terlaje and Emelia Gogo Toves Terlaje and was the fourth of nine siblings; and  
**WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jose "Pedro" Toves Terlaje is an alumni of George Washington Senior High School, having graduated in 1967. He earned an Associate of Arts in Political Science and a Bachelor of Arts in Business and Public Administration from the University of Guam in 1979; and  
**WHEREAS**, as a man of service, Senator Terlaje is a Vietnam War Veteran, having served in the United States Army as a First Sergeant, retiring after twenty (20) years. He was recognized with the Soldier of the Year Award during his service. His career continued at the Guam Police Department (GPD) for eighteen (18) years, where he also was lead of the Narcotics Division and graduated from the Drug Enforcement Administration's Drug Enforcement Academy; and  
**WHEREAS**, Senator Terlaje's community service includes his role as Director of Civil Defense under Governor Joseph F. Ada, where he led recovery efforts following Super typhoon Pamela, and as a result of his incredible efforts, he was named Vice President of the National Emergency Management Association Pacific Region; and  
**WHEREAS**, Senator Terlaje's devotion for helping improve the quality of life for the people of Guam encompasses his service as a public servant. In 1998, Senator Terlaje ran for lieutenant governor of Guam with Senator Angel Santos. The gubernatorial hopefuls ran a campaign fostered with the *Chamoru* culture and spirit in mind and coined their slogan, "HITA", which is the *Chamoru* inclusive form of "we", and the acronym meaning "Honesty, Integrity, Trust, and Accountability"; and  
**WHEREAS**, Senator Terlaje did not succeed in the gubernatorial race, he was elected Mayor of Yo'ña in 2000 and served in that role for twelve (12) years. He also served as President of the Mayor's Council of Guam and President of Association of Marianas Island Mayors; and  
**WHEREAS**, Senator Terlaje grew popular as an incredible public official as a result of his village's trust and confidence, but his love for Guam grew even more. In 2018, Senator Terlaje was elected to serve as a Member of *I Mina Trentai Sietie Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* (35<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature) and continued to serve in *I Mina Trentai Sietie Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* (36<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature). His role as Senator included the Chairmanship of the Committee on Public Safety, Emergency Response, the Mayors Council of Guam, Military and Veterans Affairs, and Mass Transit. He was known for his candor and his stout beliefs of the "HITA" approach on policy while speaking the native language of Guam, *Chamoru*; and  
**WHEREAS**, Senator Terlaje's unwavering commitment to building a better Guam will continue to benefit our people for future generations. Guam history will honor and remember him for his dedication to public service and the *Chamoru* people; and  
**WHEREAS**, Senator Terlaje's passing leaves the love of his life, his wife, Florentina "Flo" Peredo Acfalle Terlaje; their children and spouses: Joey and Melissa Gunataoas Hernandez; Joel and Genevieve Ann Sablan Leon Guerrero; Joshua and Tisha Perez; Janet & Joey Garrido; his twenty-nine (29) grandchildren and eleven (11) great-grandchildren; and his siblings Ramon and Janine Wolf Terlaje; Hylidia and Greg Perez; Elizabeth and Tony Cruz; Edward and Rosie Terlaje; Jesse and Rosemarie Terlaje; Frank and Sheri Terlaje; and Julie and Ken Williams who will continue to carry his legacy onward; now therefore, be it

*A Proclamation of the Governor*

PROCLAIMING FEBRUARY 17, 2023 IN HONORABLE RECOGNITION AND RESPECT OF JOSE "PEDRO" TOVES TERLAJE AS A FORMER MAYOR, SENATOR, ADMINISTRATOR AND VETERAN OF GUAM; AND EXPRESSING OUR HEARTFELT CONDOLENCES TO THE TERLAJE FAMILY ON BEHALF OF THE ISLAND OF GUAM.

**WHEREAS**, Jose Toves Terlaje, fondly remembered as "Pedro", was born on September 23, 1946 to Jesus Castro Terlaje and Emelia Gogo Toves of Yo'ña. He was married to Florentina "Flo" Peredo Acfalle and together they had four children, 29 grandchildren, and 11 great-grandchildren; and  
**WHEREAS**, Pedro graduated from George Washington Senior High School in 1967. He earned an Associate of Arts in Political Science and a Bachelor of Arts in Business and Public Administration from the University of Guam and University of Maryland in 1979; and  
**WHEREAS**, Pedro enlisted in the United States Army and served for 20 years, retiring at the rank of First Sergeant and as a Vietnam War veteran. He also earned the Soldier of the Year award for the IX Corp — which covered the jurisdictions of Guam, Hawaii, and Japan; and  
**WHEREAS**, Pedro then embarked on a long career in government service as a legislative aide at the Guam Legislature, Records Management Officer at the Department of Administration, and largely at the Guam Police Department — where he was recognized as a Distinguished Graduate of the Guam Military Police Academy, led the narcotics division, and served for 18 years; and  
**WHEREAS**, Pedro graduated from the Drug Enforcement Administration's Drug Enforcement Academy in Washington D.C. Later, he was appointed Civil Defense Director by Governor Joseph Ada, a position he served in for eight years, including through recovery efforts after Typhoon Pamela in 1976. He also was selected as the Vice President of the National Emergency Management Association Pacific Region; and  
**WHEREAS**, Pedro was selected as the running mate of former Senator Angel Santos in the 1998 gubernatorial election. Their campaign slogan was the *Chamoru* inclusive form of the word "we" — HITA — which stood for "Honesty Integrity Trust and Accountability". The HITA ticket placed third in the Democratic gubernatorial primary with 19% of the Democratic primary votes; and  
**WHEREAS**, Pedro was elected Mayor of Yo'ña in the 2000 mayoral election and was re-elected to two more terms in 2004 and 2008, respectively. He served for 12 years in which he also was President of the Mayor's Council of Guam and President of the Association of Marianas Island Mayors; and  
**WHEREAS**, Pedro ran as a Democratic candidate for senator in the 2018 general election and earned a seat in the 35<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature, where he served as chairperson of the Committee on Public Safety, Border Safety, Military and Veteran Affairs, Mayors Council, Infrastructure and Public Transit. He was re-elected to the 36<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature and served as chairperson of the Committee on Public Safety, Emergency Response, Mayor's Council, Military and Veterans Affairs and Mass Transit; and  
**WHEREAS**, throughout his career, Pedro worked tirelessly to serve his Island and Nation, to protect *Chamoru* heritage and promote public safety, and to champion policies relating to retirement reform, health insurance choice, and higher wages for law enforcement officers; and  
**WHEREAS**, Pedro retired from the Government of Guam after serving more than 35 years, including 12 years as mayor, eight years as an administrator, and four years as senator; and  
**WHEREAS**, Pedro passed away on January 30, 2023 at the age of 76. His legacy remains with his loved ones, especially his wife, Flo, and their children: Joey Terlaje and Melissa Gunataoas Hernandez, Joel Terlaje and Genevieve Ann Sablan Leon Guerrero, Joshua Terlaje and Tisha Perez, Janet Terlaje and Joey Garrido, and their descendants; and  
**WHEREAS**, the life and legacy of Jose "Pedro" Toves Terlaje is hereby enshrined as a valuable testament to Guam's exceptional people, and a source of pride and inspiration to all the people of Guam.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, LOURDES A. LEON GUERRERO, *Maga' hãgan Guåhan*, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do hereby call upon the people of Guam to join in commemorating the life and legacy of the Honorable Jose "Pedro" Toves Terlaje.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, I, JOSHUA F. TENORIO, *Sigundo Mago' hãgan Guåhan*, Lieutenant Governor of Guam, hereby, together with the *Maga' hãgan*, cause the Great Seal of Guam to be affixed in the Capital City of Hagåtña, on this Fifteenth day of February in the Year of our Lord, Anno Domini, Two Thousand and Twenty-Three.
