## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Authorization to Extend the Gas Tax Relief Act. All levy

- 4 surcharges on liquid fuel *shall* be waived for the remainder of Fiscal Year
- 5 2024, ending September 30, 2024.

To add a new Section of the Bill to read:

Every person or business, whether engaged in the wholesale or retail of automotive fuel products and who are no longer subject to the payment of excise taxes, automotive surcharges, and mass transit automotive surcharges on liquid fuel pursuant to this Act, shall submit to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation a written declaration, under penalty of perjury, declaring that such relief or reduction from the levy of taxes and surcharges herein were in fact not collected from the consumer and are removed from the final cost of liquid fuel products for consumers, and declaring the number of gallons of gas liquid fuel sold per month that were exempt from the liquid fuel tax pursuant to this Act.
